ANNUAL FLU VACCINATION CLINICS SCHEDULED

The Fresno County Department of Public Health has scheduled influenza vaccination clinics for the 2012 - 2013 flu season at locations throughout the county. The cost is four dollars. Medi-Cal for children and Medicare part B are accepted.

The 2012 - 2013 flu vaccine will protect against the three main influenza viruses expected to be most common during this season. Included in this year's vaccine are two influenza A viruses, A/California/7/2009 (H1N1)-like virus and A/Victoria/361/2011 (H3N2)-like virus, and one influenza B virus, B/Wisconsin/1/2010-like virus.

Federal and state guidelines recommended that everyone six months of age and older be vaccinated each year because immunity drops by as much as 50 percent 6 - 12 months after vaccination. Health officials encourage everyone to be vaccinated regardless of age or health status.

"Influenza vaccination protects against seasonal influenza infection and reduces the risk of illness, hospitalization, and even death." states Dr. Edward Moreno, Fresno County Department of Public Health, Director and Health Officer. "I urge residents to speak with their health care provider regarding influenza vaccination for themselves and their families."

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention estimates that each year in the United States more than 200,000 people are hospitalized for illnesses associated with seasonal influenza virus infections and that flu-associated deaths have ranged between 3,000 and 49,000 over the last 31 years.
