The New Health Center's Added Space Will Provide and Improve Access for Individuals and Families to Have Affordable and Quality Healthcare.

GOSHEN, Calif. – Congressman Devin Nunes, the Board and staff of Family HealthCare Network along with other dignitaries and community members attended the grand opening of the new state-of-the-art Goshen health center today.

With over 11,000 square feet of space, the new Goshen health center located near the Self-Help Enterprises Goshen Village neighborhood, offers 19 exam rooms and 9 dental operatories, providing easy access for the families of this 64-unit development, as well as all residents of Goshen. The Goshen health center will offer family and internal medicine, women's health, pediatrics and dental care, and patients will have access to the full spectrum of services offered by Family HealthCare Network.

"Family HealthCare Network has had a presence in the community of Goshen for many years, but this new health center represents a significant investment in facilities and technology," noted Harry Foster, president and chief executive officer of FHCH. "We are pleased that we can now provide our top-notch care in a beautiful new building."

Kerry Hydash, associate president and chief executive officer, added, "This new health center is a model that supports our vision for a Patient Center Health Home provided through a team-based approach. Our approach focuses on the well-being of the patient, their families and caregivers."

FHCH celebrated the grand opening today by opening for services to begin on Monday, Oct. 29 from 7 a.m. to 9 p.m. The health center will continue to offer convenient hours of service, Monday through Friday, 7 a.m. to 9 p.m. and Saturday, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Family HealthCare Network is a private, non-profit community-based organization established in 1976. The organization is governed by a volunteer Board of Directors and has developed a comprehensive primary health care delivery system with sites located in 13 locations throughout Kings County and Tulare County of which 11 are clinical sites. FHCH is accredited by the Joint Commission and home to the A.T. Stills University School of Osteopathic Medicine. FHCH is recognized by the National Committee on Quality Assurance as a Level-Three Patient Centered

Medical Health Home-and was the first California health center network awarded incentive payments for achievement of “meaningful use” of Electronic Health records.
