Summer Meal Program

Central Unified School District wants to ensure that area children continue to have access to healthy meals their summer break. With funding made possible through the United States Department of Agriculture, Summer Seamless Meals Program selected neighborhood school cafeterias with the District we will be offering free breakfast and lunch for children 18 years and younger and discounted meals will be provided for adults for \$2.50 — regardless of where you live.

There is no reason for anyone to go hungry. Central Unified believes in creating healthy communities which begins with good nutrition. The District has a goal of serving 80,000 meals this summer.

- 1. Funding for the program is made available through the United States Department of Agriculture.

- 4. Parents and/or any other adult can eat for a discounted price of \$2.50 per meal
- 5. No identification is needed or income verification
