

Timeline for Russell E. Perdock
April 28, 2006 – April 30, 2006
(all times are approximate)

Friday, April 28, 2006

- 9:00 PM - Watched TV at home.
- 10:30 PM - Went to bed.

Saturday, April 29, 2006

- 7:00 AM - Got up, fixed breakfast, instant oatmeal w/toast and coffee
- Fixed my son breakfast, instant oatmeal w/toast and juice
- As Cubmaster, I prepared for a day hike with Pack 144
- 8:45 AM - Left for a meet-up in the Rite Aid Parking Lot.
- 9:15 AM - Meet with other parents and adult leaders.
- Conduct a pack check for essentials for the day hike.
- Dave Miner, Webelos I leader present, w/ Linda Miner
- Bill Llewellyn, Bear Cub Leader, present w/ one parent
- 9:30 AM - Leave for Redbud Trail, a BLM Area at SR-20 & the North Fork of Cache Creek Wilderness Area.
- 10:00 AM - Arrive at Redbud Trail, conduct a final check and pair-up the scouts.
- 10:05 AM - Leave for hike to trails head.
- 10:45 AM - Arrive at trails head, located along ridge overlooking Cache Creek.
- Bill and the Bear Cubs turn back for the parking lot.
- Webelos I/II continue hiking up Perkins' Ridge.
- 11:45 PM - Stop for lunch on Perkins' Ridge Trail.
- 12:15 PM - Scouts and leaders decide to return to parking lot, using a shortcut.
- 1:15 PM - Arrive in parking area, hike concluded. Return to Rite Aid parking lot to meet with parents.
- 1:33 PM - Make a cellular call to contact a parent, who's still at work and not able to pick his son up. Asks to take son to my home with my son and another scout until he can pick him up.
- 2:30 PM - Scout's dad arrives at my home and picks his son up. We unpack from the hike, relax and re-hydrate while watching a baseball game.
- 4:30 PM - My son and I leave to meet with family in Lower Lake.
- 4:50 PM - Arrive in Lower Lake at the Lower Lake Pizza Company for my son's belated birthday party (11 yrs. old) with his friends, order pizzas.
- 4:55 PM - Order a glass of Coors Light, finish setting things up with my ex-wife and her parents.
- 5:15 PM - Kids start arriving with parents. Turn in beer and buy pitchers of soda and pick up glasses for drinks. Give kids quarters for video games.
- 5:30 PM - Serve pizza to kids and family. Have dinner with everyone.
- 6:10 PM - Serve birthday cake, sing and exchange gifts and guest bags.
- 6:30 PM - Area cleaned up, kids are loaded in the truck and took them home. Ex-wife heads to the store for a couple things for the sleep-over.
- 6:50 PM - Call ex-wife's cell, tell her we've returned home from pizza and ask her when she'll be home.

- 7:00 PM - Got the boys out of the truck and their stuff in the house. I uncover the boat to clean it up for a morning ride.
- 8:00 PM - Take boat to cove to launch it and tie up at docks.
- 8:30 PM - Decide to go for short ride. Pull the truck and trailer off the boat ramp and park them.
- 8:40 PM - It was getting dark so I set the stern light on the transom and turned on my navigation Idle out of the cove for a short ride. I idle E/B and see that Jim Walker is visiting (staying in a friend's house on the lake). I pulled up to their dock and he walked out to visit. Told him I was going for a short ride and asked if he and his daughter (14yrs) wanted to go for a ride.
- 8:50 PM - Pull away from the docks and started W/B toward Mt. Konocti from Lily Cove. Cruised at 30-35MPH to the front of Konocti Harbor Resort & Spa. Idled in toward the docks as Jim and I continued to visit.
- 9:00 PM - Left Konocti Harbor for home, but noticed the fuel gauge fell to empty as I powered up. It returned to about a ½ tank as the boat planed out at about 30-35MPH.
- Turned into Konocti Bay, to follow the shoreline but saw the white light of a boat off the shore in front the mobile home parks on Soda Bay Rd. So, I changed course slightly and headed Southeast and for the Richmond Park Bar & Grill. It was well lit with flood lights shinning down on the boat docks, many interior lights on with white string lights marking along the edges of the roofline. There were no visual obstructions from that position on the water to the Richmond Park Marina.
- Continued on that course, at that speed for approx. one minute +/-.
- The wind was up, with waves present and occasional whitecaps. There was no reflection of light on the water surface.
- 9:07 PM - Collided with an unlit vessel in Konocti Bay.
- After gathering my senses, I check Jim and his daughter. Both were in the boat, but Jim's daughter was complaining of serious back pain. I checked my boat's hull integrity to determine if I was taking on water. Had some water in the cabin, but it was not increasing. Checked the engine compartment and bilge for water, but found none was coming in the boat.
- 9:09 PM - Heard people calling from sail boat. Called LCSD Central Dispatch to report collision and get help started. I then restarted my boat and idled forward toward the other vessel.
- Called out to a male voice on the sailboat asking if everyone was accounted for, or if there were people in the water. A short time later I was told that everyone was onboard, but one was seriously injured.
- 9:11 PM - Called LCSD Dispatch again. Updated them on the injuries and coordinated a location to meet on the shoreline.
- 9:17 PM - Called LCSD to offer an update and change in location for EMS, to the Bay Shore Marina. Sailboat and passengers being towed into Bay Shore Marina by good samaritan.

- 9:20 PM - Called LCSD Dispatch for an update.
- 9:20 PM - Called ex-in-laws, who live very near my home, to have them tell their daughter, my ex-wife of collision and circumstance.
- 9:26 PM - Last call to LCSD Dispatch for update.
- 9:35 PM - Have arrived at beach, Bay Shore Marina, was towed in by two fishermen. Contacted EMS personnel and directed them to Jim and his daughter, Jordan who were needing help in the Baja.
- 10:00 PM - Jim and Jordan transported to Sutter Lakeside Hospital.
- Remained on shoreline near boat ramp at Bay Shore until contacted by Sgt. Ostini. Gave a statement and retrieved registration and insurance docs. from boat when asked.
- Only had one or two reception bars for cell phone. Tried to talk to family and inform them of what happened.
- 10:30 PM - Was contacted by a neighbor/friend at the beach. I asked if he could bring my truck and boat trailer back to Bay Shore to load the Baja on as evidence.
- 11:05 PM - Received a call from Craig Scoval, who had the truck and trailer and was on his way to Bay Shore.
- 11:05 PM - Left scene with Sgt. Beland, to be transported to Redbud Hospital for a voluntary blood draw for BAC.
- 11:27 PM - Called LCSD Dispatch, from the Lower Lake area to thank them for their help.
- 11:30 PM - Arrived at Redbud ER and was immediately taken into a room with the phlebotomist and Sgt. Beland for blood draw.

Sunday, April 30, 2006

- 12:12 AM - Admitted to ER for treatment of a head injury.
- Ex-wife arrives and remains in ER with me.
- Chaplain Robert Sola arrives and remains with me in the ER.
- Forehead treated for laceration. Received 20 sutures to forehead and diagnosed with a concussion.
- Called Sutter Lakeside Hospital to assure Jim and Jordan had a ride home.
- 01:50 AM - Discharged from hospital and driven home by ex-wife. Walked out with Chaplain Sola.
- 02:30 AM - Arrived home and went to bed.
- 09:00 AM - Got up.
- 10:00 AM - Walkers came by my residence to check in.
- 10:30 AM - Walkers left for home, Sacramento.
- Reported collision to insurance agent. Was asked to obtain names of all involved and if allowed to send photos of damage for pending claim.
