**COMPLAINT**

1. Complaint is hereby made against John "Jack" Dudum, P-16 Permit ("Medallion") # 1166, P-44 permit ("A-card") holder # 50619, that said Permit Holder has conducted his business in a disorderly manner and violated provisions of the San Francisco Transportation Code as described below.

2. As will be described below, Mr. Dudum's P-44 and P-16 permits are subject to discipline, including fines, suspension, and/or revocation, for good cause.

3. Mr. Dudum has held a P-44 Taxi Driver Permit ("A-card") issued by the City and County of San Francisco since December 23, 1998. See Exhibit A, Declaration of Vicky Siu. He also holds a P-16 Permit ("medallion"), which was issued on December 5, 1998 and formally granted by the Police Commission on January 7, 1999. See Exhibit B, 1998 Taxicab Issuance Declaration, and Exhibit C, Police Commission Resolution No. 2-99. This means that at the time he received his medallion from the San Francisco Police Department, Mr. Dudum had not driven one year prior to obtaining his medallion, as was required to qualify for the medallion permit. On December 5, 1998, Mr. Dudum signed a Taxicab Issuance Declaration required to obtain his medallion, in which he promised as follows: "I will personally drive the vehicle used for this taxicab permit as a full time driver, i.e., a minimum of four hours per day, 185 shifts per year." See Exhibit B.

4. **Mr. Dudum's Prior Admonishments:** Mr. Dudum was admonished for Calendar Year

1 1999 for having incomplete waybills. The admonishment, issued by the SFPD Taxi Detail, finds  
2 that he did fulfill the driving requirement in 1999. See Exhibit D, January 28, 2000

3 Admonishment. However, assuming that the 1999 waybills were not fraudulent, 1999 was  
4 apparently the last time Mr. Dudum ever drove. One year later Mr. Dudum signed a Police  
5 Department document in which she once again promised to be a full-time driver and to comply  
6 with certain other permit requirements, including filling out accurate and complete waybills. See  
7 Exhibit E, March 1, 2000 Promise signed by Mr. Dudum.

8  
9 5. He was cited by the Taxi Detail for Calendar Year 2001 when his waybills were found to  
10 be incomplete. See Exhibit F, May 15, 2002 Citation. However, the owner of Royal Taxi,  
11 Nick Sweis, later declared that there were no waybills for Mr. Dudum for Calendar Years 2000,  
12 2001, 2002, 2003, 2004, 2005, 2006, or through July 30, 2007. See Exhibit G, Declaration of Nick  
13 Sweis. The current manager of Royal Taxi, Chris Sweis, has also declared that there are no waybills  
14 for those years and for 2007, 2008, and currently for 2009. See Exhibit H, Declaration of Chris  
15 Sweis.

16  
17 6. **Mr. Dudum Failed to Meet the Proposition K Driving Requirement Since Receiving**  
18 **His Medallion:** The SFMTA was unable to confirm the existence of a single waybill  
19 submitted by Mr. Dudum for calendar years 2000, 2001, 2002, 2003, 2004, 2005, 2006, 2007, 2008,  
20 and she has yet to turn in a single waybill for calendar year 2009. Mr. Dudum has therefore failed  
21 the Proposition K driving requirement for at least calendar years 2002, 2003, 2004, 2005, 2006,  
22 2007, and 2008, and based on the declarations of Royal Taxi's management, the SFMTA believes  
23 he submitted fraudulent waybills to the Taxi Detail in 2000 and 2001 in an effort to deceive the  
24 Taxi Detail into believing she was fulfilling the driving requirement.

25  
26 7. **Mr. Dudum Is a Prosperous Business Owner While He Unlawfully Receives Lease**  
27 **Fees for the Use of Her Permit From Taxi Drivers Waiting for a Permit:** In 2007, Mr. Dudum  
28 was the subject of a KGO Channel 7 television special regarding medallion holders who illicitly

1 profit from their medallions while working taxi drivers languish for years on the medallion waiting  
2 list. Mr. Dudum and his wife were featured as medallion holders who do not drive full-time,  
3 and who have extensive business and real estate interests. Further investigation revealed these facts  
4 to be true. See Exhibit I, Declaration of Scott Leon. Given Mr. Dudum's massive real estate  
5 investments and ongoing business concerns, it is unlikely that Mr. Dudum was working as a San  
6 Francisco taxi driver during the years of 2000-2009.

7  
8 **8. Mr. Dudum Does Not Have an Airport "Smart Card."** As further evidence that he  
9 has never driven a taxicab in San Francisco, Ms. Dudum does not even have a "smart card" account  
10 at the Airport. See Exhibit J, Declaration of Christina Sayborivong. This is additional evidence that  
11 he is not driving, as the vast majority of taxicab drivers have obtained a smart card in order to  
12 be able to compete for lucrative fares from the 16,000,000 passengers per year who need  
13 transportation from the San Francisco International Airport..

14  
15 **9. Mr. Dudum Repeatedly and Falsely Pledged to Operate His Taxicab According to**  
16 **Local Law:** As described above, when Mr. Dudum received his permit in January 1999 he  
17 signed a Declaration, "Taxicab Issuance Declaration," in which he pledged to "personally drive the  
18 vehicle used for this taxicab permit as a full time driver..." among other duties, and signed a second  
19 document in March 2000 promising to be a full-time driver. These were false statements. See  
20 Exhibits B and E.

21 **10. Mr. Dudum Falsely Declared Under Penalty of Perjury That His Permit Was in**  
22 **Compliance with Local Law:** Ms. Dudum submitted annual Form 1095 filings required by Trans.  
23 Code § 1114(c)(1) (former Municipal Police Code § 1095) in which he declared that he  
24 was in full compliance with local law. He submitted these Form 1095s for Calendar Years 2000-  
25 2008 and he was not in compliance with the law for any of those years. See Exhibit K, Form 1095s  
26 for Calendar Years 2000-2009.

27  
28 **11. Mr. Dudum is Charged with Twelve Violations of Trans. Code § 1105(a)(8):** Trans.

1 Code § 1105(a)(8) provides as follows:

2 Every Permit Holder shall at all times, fully cooperate with a Parking Control  
3 Officer, peace officer or the Director, or his or her designee, on all matters relating to  
4 regulatory compliance at all times, including but not limited to compliance with  
5 requests for the inspection of records. Permit Holders shall not hinder, delay or  
6 knowingly make false or misleading statements to a peace officer or to the SFMTA  
7 or withhold information on any matter relating to regulatory compliance.

8 Mr. Dudum has made repeated false statements to the SFMTA as described above, including  
9 (1) signing false documents and pledges and (2) falsely declaring under penalty of  
10 perjury that he was operating his medallion in compliance with local law. A violation of  
11 Trans. Code § 1105(a)(8) carries a penalty of \$250 for the first offense, \$500 for a second  
12 offense, and \$1000 for subsequent offenses.

13 12. **Mr. Dudum is Charged with Nine Violations of Trans. Code § 1109(c)(1):** Trans. Code §  
14 1109(c)(1) provides as follows: "every Medallion Holder subject to the provisions of this section  
15 1109(c) shall be a Full-Time Driver." A Full-Time Driver is defined in Trans. Code § 1102(l) as  
16 "any Driver actually engaged in, or the activity comprised of (respectively) the mechanical  
17 operation and physical charge and custody of a Taxi or Ramp Taxi which is available for hire or  
18 actually hired for at least 156 four-hour shifts or 800 hours, whichever shall come first." Mr.  
19 Dudum has failed the driving requirement on at least nine separate occasions, and the SFMTA  
20 submits that he is on track to fail it for 2009 as well.

21 13. Trans. Code § 1120(a) and (b) provide as follows:

22 (a) Any permit issued under this Article may be suspended or revoked by the  
23 SFMTA for good cause after a noticed hearing. "Good cause" hereunder shall  
24 include, but shall not be limited to, the following:

25 (1) A Medallion Holder ceased to be a Full-Time Driver...

26 (4) A Permit Holder or an agent of a Permit Holder knowingly made false  
27 statements to or concealed information from the SFMTA or the Chief of  
28 Police...

(b) The SFMTA shall have discretion to suspend or revoke a permit as set forth above,  
except that a suspension and/or revocation shall be mandatory in the circumstances  
described in Subsections (1) through (6) above.

14. **Conclusion:** Mr. Dudum has not only repeatedly failed to fulfill the Proposition K

1 driving requirement, but he has submitted false documents in an effort to deceive the SFPD, the  
2 Taxi Commission, and now the SFMTA into believing that he was fulfilling his driving  
3 requirement. The Division of Taxis and Accessible Services submits that Mr. Dudum has never  
4 driven a taxicab in San Francisco despite his false statements to the contrary. While he deceived  
5 the regulatory authorities, he unlawfully reaped the benefit of his P-16 permit while hard-working  
6 drivers paid him lease fees that he was not entitled to. He has violated the Proposition K driving  
7 requirement for at least calendar years 2002, 2003, 2004, 2005, 2006, 2007, and 2008, and it is  
8 reasonable to infer that he was also in violation during Calendar Years 2000-2001 by submitting  
9 false waybills.

10  
11 15. Violations of the Proposition K driving requirement, Trans. Code § 1109(c)(a), carry a fine  
12 of up to \$30/hr for each hour a medallion holder falls short of the requirement. Therefore, for his  
13 violations of the Proposition K driving requirement, Mr. Dudum may be fined \$24,000 for each  
14 year he fell short (\$30/hr x 800 hours). Mr. Dudum fell short for nine calendar years, for a total of  
15 \$188,000 (\$24,000 x 4 years.) He also made false statements in violation of Trans. Code §  
16 1105(a)(8), and can be fined up to a total of \$7,750 for filing false Form 1095s (\$250 for the first  
17 incident, \$500 for the second, and \$1000 for each of the seven subsequent fraudulent filings). His  
18 other false statements contained in Exhibits B and E may also be fined at the rate of \$250 for the  
19 first violation and \$500 for the second, for a total of \$8,500 for false statements made over the  
20 years.

21 16. The Division of Taxis and Accessible Services also requests revocation of his taxi medallion  
22 permit as a necessary penalty in this case considering the many years of deceit, and failure to drive  
23 his medallion to the detriment of hard-working taxi drivers who are waiting for their medallion. .  
24 Mr. Dudum is unfit to be a member of the San Francisco taxicab industry. Pursuant to Trans. Code  
25 § 1120(a) and (b), his P-16 and P-44 permits must be revoked. Considering the egregiousness of his  
26 violations, his prior disciplinary history, and the length of time of his deception, fines at a minimum  
27 of \$10,000 should be imposed, in addition to revocation of the permit.

On January 24, 2000, the Taxi Detail conducted an audit of your waybills to determine if you were in compliance with the "full time driver" requirement as specified in Section 1081 (b) of the San Francisco Municipal Police Code.

The result of our audit indicates that you were in compliance with the full time driving requirement. In addition, while auditing waybills, officers found that your waybills incomplete.

Section 1138 of the San Francisco Municipal Police Code requires that drivers of taxicabs keep an accurate and legible waybill which includes the date of operation, starting & ending times, vehicle license#, cab#, medallion#, starting and ending mileage & units, time of hire and discharge of passenger and the locations of fare pickup and drop off.


In addition, Section VI. C. 8. of the San Francisco Taxicab/Ramped Taxi Rules and regulations requires that waybills be completed in indelible ink and signed by the driver at the start of the shift.

This letter is to act as a FORMAL ADMONISHMENT. When conducting future audits, only completed waybills will be used in determining the total number of days /shifts worked. In addition, you must drive your own medallion number taxicab when complying with this full time driving requirement as per Section IV A. 10. of the San Francisco Taxicab/Ramped Taxi Rules & Regulations.

This is to act in lieu of any further disciplinary action on this matter.

Violations of any of the codes and/or rules regulating the taxicab industry is punishable by an admonishment, non-traffic infraction, misdemeanor, fine, administrative reprimand, suspension or revocation.

To: All Prop K Medallion Holders

On 01/25/00, the Taxi Commission adopted Resolution #2000-05 defining "Business Day" and what constitutes the number of "Business Days" in the calendar year as per the driving requirement specified in Proposition K. The Commission approved the definition of "Business days" as days that are based upon four 10 hour days per week. Furthermore, the Commission set the required number of shifts needed to meet the Proposition K driving requirement as 156 shifts per calendar year.

The Taxicab Detail, when conducting future Prop K audits or when investigating complaints of Prop K violations will enforce this new resolution requiring that Medallion Holders drive at least 4 hours during any 24 hour period for at least 156 shifts per calendar year.

In addition, Medallion Holders must adhere to the below listed rules and regulations concerning waybills.

Section 1138 of the San Francisco Municipal Police Code requires that drivers of taxicabs keep an accurate and legible waybill which includes the date of operation, driver's name, vehicle license#, cab#, medallion#, starting & ending times, starting & ending mileage, starting & ending units, number of passengers, origin and destination of each trip, time of hire and discharge and the fare amount.

Section VI. C. 8. of the San Francisco Taxicab/Ramped Taxi Rules and regulations requires that waybills be completed in indelible ink, signed by the driver at the start of the shift and filed at the Color Scheme's place of business at the conclusion of each shift.

Section IV A. 10. of the San Francisco Taxicab/Ramped Taxi Rules & Regulations requires that unless their taxicab is out of service, all Medallion Holders must drive only their own medallion number taxicab when complying with the "Prop K" full time driving requirement.

Only the original waybills that are both accurate and complete will be counted when measuring the total number of shifts worked per calendar year.

Furthermore, requests for either a 90 day suspension of the driving requirement or a modification of the driving requirement under the provisions of the Americans with Disabilities Act must be made in writing to the Taxi Commission.



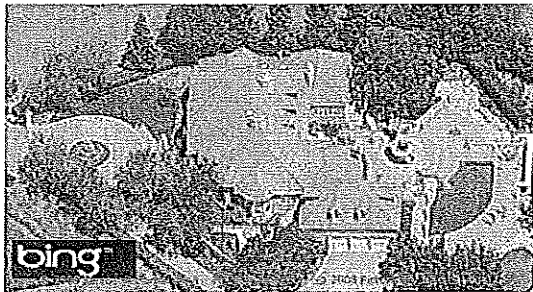

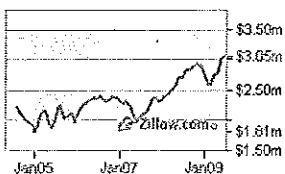

# EXHIBIT J

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1. I am over 18 years old and a citizen of the United States, and I am not a party to this action.

2. My name is Christina Sayborivong, and my business address is San Francisco International Airport, DAJA International Office, San Francisco, CA. I am employed at the DAJA Office as an Administrative Assistant. DAJA International is contracted with the Airport to manage curbside management of shuttle vans, taxicabs, and limousines. I have held that position since October 2008. In that capacity, and as part of my regular duties, I am responsible for general office duties. I am also responsible for registering and issuing "smart cards" for the "Smart Card Program" at the Airport, and I register and issue replacement smart cards. The Smart Card Program allows taxi drivers to access the Airport's garages, so they can pick up fares at the Airport. I provide customer service for taxi drivers, including the processing of refunds for Smart Cards which allow them to access the Airport's taxi lots, so they can pick up fares at the Airport. I see taxi drivers when they come into the office to obtain customer service. I also see them when I go out to the three lots that the Airport provides for taxis to queue up as they wait for passengers at the terminals. Part of my duties involve regularly visiting these lots and the taxi stands at the terminals. I also print reports for government agencies such as the SFMTA and I serve as custodian of records for these reports.

3. The Smart Card program began in June 2007 when DAJA implemented the system at the Airport's request. No San Francisco taxi driver or medallion holder can pick up any passengers at the airport without a Smart Card, because no driver can enter the parking lot without a Smart Card. Records of drivers' activities at the Airport are kept by individual accounts on a computer system. The account registers transactions each time that a driver uses a particular Smart Card to enter the Airport, makes a payment for his visit to the Airport, checks out of the Airport, and adds funds to the Card's account.

1 4. On July 6, 2009, I reviewed the electronic records for the Smart Card Program at the  
2 request of the SFMTA's Division of Taxis and Accessible Services. The SFMTA wanted me to  
3 provide a report for Mr. Jack Dudum. I searched the records but I was unable to find an  
4 account for Mr. Dudum, which indicates that he does not possess a smart card and would therefore  
5 be unable to pick up passengers at the Airport. From my experience this is extremely unusual as  
6 most drivers do serve the Airport and therefore obtain a smart card account.

7  
8 5. I testify to the validity of this report, my statements in this declaration, and I am  
9 knowledgeable from my experience as Administrative Assistant that the records are accurate.

10 6. I declare under penalty and perjury of the State of California that the foregoing is true and  
11 correct.
