

**Dreier LLP Partners Jay K. Reisinger and Thomas J. Farrell, along with James E. Sharp, of Sharp & Associates, have released the following statement with respect to Andy Pettitte's testimony before the House Committee on Oversight and Government Reform:**

“Andy has fully answered all of the inquiries of the House Committee on Oversight and Government Reform in a sworn deposition. He cooperated fully with the Committee, and in addition to his sworn deposition, he provided the Committee with a sworn affidavit. In that affidavit, Andy informed the Committee that in addition to the two shots a day of HGH he took for two days in 2002, he also took HGH for a one-day period in 2004, shortly preceding season-ending elbow surgery. Andy had not previously mentioned this usage because he acquired the substance from his father, who had obtained it without Andy's knowledge in an effort to overcome his very serious health problems, which have included serious cardiac conditions. Andy did not want his father, whom he deeply respects and loves, to be brought into this matter and sought to shield him from publicity. In both cases, Andy used HGH in a misguided effort to recover from injury.

Andy is deeply saddened by the toll that the investigation has taken on everyone involved. He is very much looking forward to putting this matter behind him and getting back to the sport he loves. Andy is eager to be back with his Yankee teammates, preparing for the upcoming season.”

Andy will personally address the media and the public upon arriving at spring training.
