## **H1N1 VACCINE CLINIC INFORMATION**

The Houston Department of Health and Human Services is offering the H1N1 nasal spray vaccine (live attenuated intra-nasal) to healthy individuals ages 2-49 years of age.

H1N1 vaccine is available on a first come, first serve basis at the following sites beginning Wednesday October 28, 2009 from 9:00AM to 1:00PM and 2:00PM to 7:00PM.

Pregnant women and children with underlying health conditions will be eligible for a very limited supply of the injectable H1N1 vaccine.
