This is a 12-18 month internship program designed to attract individuals to editorial positions and to groom potential future managers for KTRK-TV and other ABC, Inc. properties. The objectives of the program are to enhance the skills of individuals interested in pursuing News Management careers, to promote diversity, and to increase minority and female representation in key decision-making positions. As designed, the Program is open to qualified applicants of all races, but consistent with the stated objectives as well as laws governing affirmative action plans, a preference is accorded to minority applicants on the basis of their race. This is not limited to existing station personnel. Currently, Jaime Martinez, Associate Producer, is participating in the Broadcast Training Program.
