GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, I am a Magistrate in and for Harris County, Texas and WHEREAS, Deputy D. Wolford, a peace officer employed by the Harris County Sheriff's Office, hereafter called AFFIANT, came before me this day with a sworn affidavit, which is attached hereto and is specifically incorporated by reference for all purposes, requesting a warrant; and WHEREAS, I have made inquiry of the basis of said beliefs of the AFFIANT and find that the Affidavit sets forth substantial facts establishing that probable cause does exist for the issuance of a warrant, that the person, place or thing to be searched is not one which is prohibited nor beyond the authorization of this Magistrate and that the search is requested upon proper grounds.



AFFIDAVIT FOR SEARCH WARRANT

I, D. Wolford, a peace officer employed by the Harris County Sheriff's Office do solemnly swear that I have reason to believe and do believe that within a location there exists evidence of property acquired by theft, property specially designed, made, or adapted for or commonly used in the commission of an offense, weapons prohibited by the Penal Code, a drug, controlled substance, immediate precursor, or other controlled substance property, any property the possession of which is prohibited by law, implements or instruments used in the commission of a crime, and property or items constituting evidence tending to show that a particular person, namely DYLAN ANDREW QUICK, committed the offense of Aggravated Assault, including, but not limited to, identification papers, documents, books, hair, blood, fibers, fingerprints, clothing, backpacks, cell phones, weapons, and other firearms evidence, currency, electronic devices, such as a personal computers, printers, recording devices, and other evidence as alleged in the attached affidavit in a manner authorized by law.

The location is a single family residence, located at [REDACTED] in Houston, Harris County, Texas. There is, at this location, a one story, single family residence and an attached garage that sits slightly to the front of the residence. The residence is an orange in color brick structure with white trim sitting on the northeast side of Jenikay Street facing southwest. The residence has a white in color wooden front door with a glass screen door that faces southwest. The garage doors also face southwest and are white in color. The number [REDACTED] is affixed above the front door and on the street curb located directly in front of the residence.

MY BELIEF IS BASED UPON THE FOLLOWING FACTS:

Your Affiant, D. Wolford, is a peace officer under the laws of the State of Texas and is currently employed with Harris County Sheriff's Office currently assigned to the Homicide Division. Your Affiant has been in the field of law enforcement for approximately 15 years; is an experienced criminal investigator, has no criminal record, is credible and reliable, and thus, is worthy of belief.
