


- DIY sandal loops
- leather lacing, length to taste
- thread through toe loop
- double knot, twice
- to lace up: twist after each wrap so it stays up. Tie in the back. Still slipping? Lotion.
- wear and be fab!

- DIY thread loops
- chiffon/scarf material (hint: shop discounted remnants!)
- thread through toe loop
- twist to knuckles
- thread through arch loops
- tie snug in bow around heel, snip ends
- hot glue an embellishment to taste



- hot glue
- jewelry embellishment

...gold hardware is the easiest and trendiest way to stretch your flipflop dollar! Even just a touch can glam up your simple ensemble.

## Unit-tee-cle







- DIY thread loops
- grab your tee, cut three strips from the bottom
- "un-loop" them
- knot them all together at one end, start braiding, knot the end
- thread the braid through... According to mood! You can't go wrong.



- Handy Tools: scissors, sewing scissors, hot glue gun, t-shirt, chiffon/soft material, jewelry embellishments/beading.
- When not handling hot glue, put the flip flop on your foot as you go-- so you can see how it looks and what you like!
- DIY thread loops (need regular scissors, leather lacing, hot glue gun): Snip off the y-shaped strap at the base. Remove, but keep the "stoppers" at hand. Cut 3 small strips of leather to make the loops.
- apply a dab of hot glue and seal with the stopper on the sole of the sandal.
- repeat on all 3 and let cool!
- Sewing scissors make worlds difference when cutting material especially like chiffon and t-shirt
