According to CityData.com, almost one in four children in Humble live in poverty. The Humble ISD has 11 Title One schools, meaning more than 40 percent of students qualify for free or reduced lunches. Those meals may be their main or only meal of the day.

Affording school supplies is also a problem for these children. Few disadvantaged families can afford the \$80 or so that it costs to buy the needed supplies.

HAAM serves these families through donations of school supplies, food, and more. Much more!

So instead of making a donation to my campaign please consider a donation to those who are eliminating the barriers to opportunity in under-served communities.

According to CBS, Americans spent \$6.8 billion on political campaigns last year – *just on the federal level.*
