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## INTRODUCTION

Student attendance is vital to the Houston Independent School District since it directly impacts student achievement as well as generates revenue from the state. Improving student attendance, and preventing and recovering dropouts are the primary objectives of the Attendance/Tuancy Specialists. The Attendance/Tuancy Specialists perform and are responsible for the following duties:

- Monitor, direct and assist the school attendance clerks in sending out the state mandated 3-Day Truancy Notices and 10-Day Court Referrals.
- Make home visits to investigate cases of nonattendance and counsel with parents and students to improve school attendance, thus increasing ADA monies from the state.
- Refer students and families to social agencies for assistance.
- Prepare and file Truancy Court Cases and represent the District in Truancy Court.
- Document the results of Truancy Court for state mandated PEIMS reporting.
- Make home visits and utilize other investigative procedures to reclaim and redirect Dropouts.
- Investigate and document efforts to locate “No-Shows” and “School Leavers” for state mandated Data Quality and Dropout reporting.
- Make home visits to verify addresses.

For school year 2008-09, there were 10 Attendance/Tuancy Specialists under the direction of the Student Engagement Department to service over 300 schools with over 190,000 students. Additionally, a few schools hired their own Attendance Specialists and the West Region had a special Dropout Prevention program. Also, HISD Police, Precinct 6 Constables’ Absent Student Assistance Program (ASAP) issued truancy citations in some schools. The Central and South Regions participated in the Harris County Stay in School program.

This report is a compilation of data submitted by the Attendance/Tuancy Specialists. The data regarding the 3-Day Truancy Notices, the 10-Day Court Referrals, and Juvenile Probation Letters was submitted by the school attendance clerks. Membership and Percentage of Attendance data in this report was taken from Federal and State Compliance PEIMS records. Blank spaces indicate that no data was received.

During school year 2008-2009, 25,491 Attendance Referrals were worked, 16,365 Warning Notices were issued and 11,545 Court Cases were filed by the Attendance/Tuancy Specialists. In compliance with Senate Bill 1432, the schools sent 59,389 Three-Day Truancy Notices, 13,169 Ten-Day Court referrals, and 180 Juvenile Probation Letters. The HISD Police and ASAP Deputies issued 1,835 Truancy Citations. Statistical compilation tables continue on the following pages. Below is a history of attendance activities for the past 10 years.
