## Incident Report Pasadena Police Department

## **Narrative**

ID-14. Also collected was the pry bar / tire tool, from the back yard of 7422 Timberline. The item was placed in an evidence bag and later labeled ID-15.

Detective M. Bruegger requested a walk through with Joseph Horn be video taped. The video tape of the officer walk through was later tagged as ID-1.

After completing the walk through video I processed the scene at 7422 Timberline for latent prints. Using the Sirchie CyanoWand I fumed (superglue) the area around the point of entry, including the bathtub, and the closet door east of the bathtub. Using black fingerprint powder and a dusting brush I processed the area around the point of entry (window and window sill) in the master bathroom. I processed the bathtub and area around the bathtub to include the bottom of the tub and the walls. Using this process I was unable to develop any latent prints. I processed the rest of the master bathroom, but met with negative results. I then processed for fingerprint the blocks of glass from the outside, below the point of entry. Again, I was unable to develop any prints.

I returned to the Pasadena Police Department and secured the evidence in the office of the Crime Scene Unit / Identification Division. I took the evidence to the processing room. I first removed the tan bag, which had been collected from the front yard of 7422 Timberline, and photographed it before inventorying its contents. I removed each piece and photographed the items. The contents of the bag are as follows:

- ID-3 a small brown case containing a total of \$245, jewelry, and Miscellaneous papers
- ID-4 a Texas Commerce Bank, money bag containing a total of \$2,986
- ID-5 a Washington Mutual bank, money bag containing a total of \$630
- ID-6 was the bag itself with miscellaneous items
- ID-7 a black jewelry box with several pieces of miscellaneous jewelry
- ID-8 a red jewelry box with a silver bracelet
- ID-9 a plastic zip lock bag with 7 gold bracelets and 1 green bracelet
- ID-10 a small black jewelry box with sapphire type jewelry
- ID-11 a light green travel / toiletry kit with miscellaneous papers and Jewelry boxes containing jewelry

The items were photographed and packaged separately. On 11-20-07 at around 10:30am I released these items Detective M. Bruegger.

Items labeled ID-12, ID-13, ID-14, and ID-15 were sealed in evidence bags and logged into the Pasadena Police Property Room. A copy of each video was made and the copies were given to Detective M. Bruegger. The video tapes were logged into the Pasadena Police Property Room.
