What the chart shows The chart shows three measures of hospital safety: our hospital safety score, and two measures that focus on mortality.

Safety score: This combines five safety categories—communications, infections, readmissions, unnecessary CT scanning, and mortality—into a score between 1 and 100. There are two mortality measures, both of which are components of the safety score.

Avoiding Mortality-Medical: This is based on the chance that a patient who has had a heart attack or been diagnosed with heart failure or pneumonia will die within 30 days of entering the hospital. Avoiding Mortality-Surgical: This looks at surgery patients who had serious but treatable complications—such as blood clots in the legs or lungs, or cardiac arrest—and died in the hospital.
