NOTICE OF REJECTION

The Chicago Teachers Union, Local 1, American Federation of Teachers, AFL-CIO, serves notice that it REJECTS the recommended terms of settlement contained in the Fact-Finding panel's July 18, 2012 Report.

The rejection is made on the basis of the concurrence and dissent set forth by Union Panel Member Sharkey. Since the Illinois Educational Labor Relations Act allows the parties only to accept or reject the recommendation in its entirety, and because the Chicago Teachers Union cannot accept the recommendation in its entirety, the Union must reject it.

The Union appreciates the efforts of the panel members and hopes that the recommendations will assist the parties in achieving a negotiated contract settlement.
