While in the area, I located what appeared to be grey fibers on the inside of the rail on the Sheridan Road bridge which crosses over the harbor. I contacted Evidence Technician Officer C. Detective Bartz contacted Wilmette Fire Department and they responded with an underwater camera. Detective Bartz and several member of Wilmette Fire used a harbor boat to attempt to locate Maddula's eye glasses in the harbor. They were unable to locate anything of evidentiary value. 
