he had [redacted] and possibly [redacted] in his room for a "pre-game" party. [redacted] said at some point [redacted] stopped by the room. [redacted] said they were drinking alcohol and smoking marijuana.

[redacted] said he and [redacted] had purchased alcohol earlier in the night at Evanston 1st Liquors. [redacted] said they asked someone on the street to purchase them liquor and he bought rum and [redacted] bought vodka. [redacted] said while they were in his room, he took three shots of rum and [redacted] took two shots of vodka. [redacted] said he smoked marijuana and said [redacted] also smoked a "one-hitter" of marijuana.

[redacted] said the group then met up with [redacted] and left PARC for some parties off campus. [redacted] said the group left his room ahead of him and he caught up with them on the street prior to arriving at the first party located somewhere on Garnett. [redacted] said he had one to two more drinks and he recalls [redacted] having another shot. [redacted] said the group stayed there for approximately 15-20 minutes. [redacted] said the original PARC group then went to 2013 Ridge.

[redacted] said he did not recall walking to 2013 Ridge with [redacted] but he did see him inside of the party. [redacted] said he stayed at the party for approximately 20 minutes and he then left with [redacted] to go to a party on Hamlin. [redacted] said when he and [redacted] left, the PARC group was still all at 2013 Ridge.

[redacted] said he and [redacted] stayed at Hamlin for approximately 30 minutes and could not leave because the police were out front for a bit. [redacted] said he did not see anyone from the PARC group at Hamlin besides [redacted]. [redacted] said he and [redacted] parted ways and [redacted] went to Garnett by himself for approximately 10 minutes. [redacted] said he then went to Burger King by himself and went to back to PARC by himself. It should be noted [redacted] returned to PARC on 09/22/2012 at 01:13:41 hours according to the surveillance video at the dormitory. It does appear [redacted] returns to PARC with a Burger King bag. [redacted] said he was only at 2013 Ridge one-time throughout the night and did not return once he left.

[redacted] did not have anything additional to add or ask. [redacted] said he would participate in a polygraph examination if needed.

Detective Kubiak and I interviewed [REDACTED] see Detective Kubiak's Supplemental Report for details.

On 10/05/2012, Detective Kubiak and I picked-up [REDACTED] at PARC and transported him back to the Evanston Police Department. [REDACTED] stated the following, in summary and not verbatim:

[REDACTED] said he went to [REDACTED] room with [REDACTED] and for part of the time [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] said he and [REDACTED] drank vodka together but he did not know how much [REDACTED] consumed. [REDACTED] said the group then left for the first party, which he thought was on Hamlin. [REDACTED] said they were at the party for approximately 15-20 minutes and left for 2013 Ridge. [REDACTED] said the original PARC group went to 2013 Ridge and he remembers [REDACTED] being in the group. [REDACTED] said they were at the party for approximately 30 minutes and he saw [REDACTED] take one shot of rum. [REDACTED] said [REDACTED] already seemed intoxicated and he was slurring his speech and "wobbly" in his walking. [REDACTED] said he then went to another party, possibly on Hamlin, with the original PARC group minus [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] who stayed at 2013 Ridge.

[REDACTED] said the rest of group stayed at the party for approximately 40 minutes. [REDACTED] said the remaining group went to look for a party on Gaffield, but when they could not find the party, they returned to 2013 Ridge. [REDACTED] said at some point [REDACTED] called [REDACTED] and remembers her stating [REDACTED] reported he was back at PARC. [REDACTED] said when they returned to 2013 Ridge, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] were no longer at the party. [REDACTED] said [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] then left together, reportedly to return to PARC. [REDACTED] said he [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] stayed out party hopping until 0130-0200 hours when they returned to PARC. [REDACTED] said the last time he saw [REDACTED] was at 2013 Ridge with [REDACTED] and other former PARC residents. Detective Kubiak and I then drove [REDACTED] back home.

Detective Kubiak and I then picked up [REDACTED] for an interview and escorted him to the Evanston Police Department. See Detective Kubiak's Supplemental Report for additional details.

Detective Kubiak then picked up [REDACTED] conducted the interview in our unmarked squad car due to time constraints. [REDACTED] stated the following, in summary and not verbatim:

[REDACTED] said he went to [REDACTED] room with [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. When they arrived, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] were in the room. [REDACTED] said [REDACTED] stopped by for a brief time. [REDACTED] said he was drinking and he saw [REDACTED] drink three shots of vodka.

[REDACTED] said the PARC group then left for a party on Garnett, where they stayed for 45 minutes. [REDACTED] said the group then went to 2013 Ridge, where he saw [REDACTED] take two more shots and drink a beer. [REDACTED] said he spoke with [REDACTED] for a little bit. [REDACTED] said when they were leaving, he had assisted [REDACTED] out of the party due to his level of intoxication. [REDACTED] said [REDACTED] knocked over the mailbox on the front porch and there was a slight verbal altercation with some residents of the 2013 Ridge house. [REDACTED] said [REDACTED] picked up the mailbox and the incident was finished. [REDACTED] said the group then split up and he does not know where [REDACTED] went and does not remember the remainder of the night. Detective Kubiak concluded the interview.

On 10/08/2012, I called B'Hai Temple security and spoke with Lieutenant Reynolds who stated his staff reviewed the video with negative results. Lieutenant Reynolds said the hard drive crashed and the video had been since lost.

On 10/09/2012, Detective B. Bartz #178 and I went to Wilmette Harbor to view the water since it was reported to be clear. While in the area, I located what appeared to be grey fibers on the inside of the rail on the Sheridan Road bridge which crosses over the harbor. I contacted Evidence Technician Officer C. DeFranceschi #108 and she responded to collect the evidence. See Officer DeFranceschi's Evidence Technician report for further details.

Detective Bartz contacted Wilmette Fire Department and they responded with an underwater camera. Detective Bartz and several member of Wilmette Fire used a harbor boat to attempt to locate Maddula's eye glasses in the harbor. They were unable to locate anything of evidentiary value.

[REDACTED] said he was playing video games the night of the party. [REDACTED] said at the party he was on the porch and in the backyard. [REDACTED] said he does not know [REDACTED] and did not know what he looked like the night of the party. [REDACTED] said he is not a "Fiji" fraternity member. [REDACTED] said he did not know "Fiji" to task people with things like scavenger hunts or tasks. [REDACTED] said the night of the party, he thought [REDACTED] was bartending the night of the party. [REDACTED] said he did not witness the mailbox getting knocked over, but did hear that someone knocked over the mailbox. [REDACTED] said he had heard from [REDACTED] that [REDACTED] was drunk at the party and that [REDACTED] lives at the "Fiji" house. [REDACTED] said [REDACTED] was no longer a "Fiji" member and quit due to this incident or his studies. Detective Kubiak and I then drove [REDACTED] home.

Detective Kubiak and I then picked up [REDACTED] at Sheridan and Circle Arts Drive in Evanston and transported him to the Evanston Police Department. Upon our arrival at the police station, [REDACTED] stated the following, in summary and not verbatim:

[REDACTED] said when he arrived at 2013 Ridge, [REDACTED] was there with the PARC group. [REDACTED] stated he said hello to [REDACTED] and then made his way around the party. [REDACTED] said the bartender at the party was
