

MOTION TO INTERVENE

Pursuant to Rule 24 of the North Carolina Rules of Civil Procedure, Carlton Patrick Currin and Juanita P. Currin, Carlton Patrick Currin, Jr., intervenors, move the Court for permission to intervene as parties in this action, on the following grounds:

1. This is an action in which the Plaintiffs sought and were granted *ex parte* temporary custody of the minor child, Carolyn Haley Morris born May 3, 2003.
2. The Intervenor Carlton Patrick Currin and Juanita P. Currin are the father and the step-mother of the defendant, Kelley Currin Morris, and the maternal grandfather and step-grandmother of the minor child. Intervenor Carlton Patrick Currin, Jr., is the maternal uncle of the minor child.
3. The Plaintiffs herein filed a complaint with this Court on or about November 24, 2008 seeking custody of said minor child. The Plaintiffs gave no notice of this action, whatsoever, to Intervenor-Movants herein despite the requirements of NCGS Chapter 50A-205.
4. Intervenor-Movants herein have as much if not more of a claim to the physical and legal custody of said minor child as the Plaintiffs and therefore were entitled to notice of this action.
5. Intervenor-Movants' daughter and sister, Kelly Currin Morris, has been missing since on or about September 3, 2008 and is presumed to be deceased.
6. The Intervenor-Movants, Carlton Patrick Currin and Juanita P. Currin have been active in the minor child, Carolyn Haley Morris' life. Said child has a close, loving relationship with said Intervenor. Prior to disappearance of the defendant, Kelly Currin Morris, the Intervenor-grandfather saw the child on a nearly daily basis, and both Intervenor saw the child on regular overnight visits in their home. During the last six months of 2006, the defendants and the minor child lived with the Intervenor in their home. Since that time, the child and her mother, together with Taylor Brogden, the minor child's sister, would stay for visits with the Intervenor. During the spring into the summer of 2008, the minor child and the defendant, Kelly Currin Morris lived with the Intervenor.

7. The Intervenor, Carlton Patrick Currin, Jr., "Carl", is the maternal uncle of the minor child, and has had a good and loving relationship with the child.

8. Upon information and belief, the Intervenor and said child saw each other much more frequently than said child and Plaintiffs. Both Intervenor were very active in said minor child's life.

9. This Court has entered a Temporary Order in this matter, without notice to Intervenor-Movants. The Intervenor-Movants had to find out this action was pending when it was mentioned in the Oxford newspaper.

10. This action was filed in Durham County despite the fact that no party lives in Durham County and the child has never lived in Durham County. Upon information and belief, it is alleged that the action was purposefully filed outside Granville County in further attempt to ensure that Intervenor-Movants knew nothing of the action.


11. It is in the best interest of the minor child that her custody be placed with the Intervenor-Movants.



14. The Intervenor-Movants pray this Court that this verified Motion be received as an Affidavit.



ANSWER AND COUNTERCLAIM OF
INTERVENORS

Now come the Intervenor to answer the complaint, filed by Plaintiffs, as follows:

1. The allegations contained in paragraph one are admitted.
2. With regard to the allegations contained in paragraph two, it is admitted that the Defendant is William Scott Morris is a citizen and resident of Granville County, North Carolina and that he has resided there for at least six months next preceding the institution of this action. It is also admitted that Kelly Currin Morris was a citizen and resident of Granville County, North Carolina, it being affirmatively alleged that said Kelly Currin Morris has been missing since September 3, 2008 and is presumed deceased.
3. The allegations contained in paragraphs three, four and five are admitted.
4. With regard to the allegations contained in paragraph six, the Intervenor do not have sufficient information with which to admit or deny said allegations, therefore they are denied.
5. The allegations contained in paragraphs seven and eight are admitted.
6. The allegations contained in paragraph nine are admitted in that it is admitted that the child is the Plaintiffs' only grandchild. The remainder of said allegations is denied.
7. With regard to the allegations contained in paragraphs ten and eleven, the Intervenor are without sufficient information to admit or deny said allegations, therefore said allegations are denied.

NOW, AS A FURTHER ANSWER AND REPLY AND COUNTERCLAIM, the Intervenor allege as follows:

1. The Intervenor, Carlton Patrick Currin and wife, Juanita P. Currin, have been citizens and residents of Granville County, North Carolina for more than six months next preceding the filing of this action residing at 3195 Range Road, Stem, NC 27581.

NOW, AS A FURTHER ANSWER AND REPLY AND COUNTERCLAIM, the Intervenor allege as follows:

1. The Intervenor, Carlton Patrick Currin and wife, Juanita P. Currin, have been citizens and residents of Granville County, North Carolina for more than six months next preceding the filing of this action residing at 3195 Range Road, Stem, NC 27581.

2. The Intervenor, Carlton Patrick Currin, Jr., is a resident of Granville County, North Carolina.

3. The Defendant, William Scott Morris, is a resident of Granville County, North Carolina.

4. The Defendants, William Scott Morris and Kelly Currin Morris, daughter of the Intervenor, Carlton Patrick Currin, were married on March 9, 2002.

5. One child was born of the marital relationship between the Defendant, William Scott Morris and Kelly Currin Morris, namely, Carolyn Haley Morris, date of birth: May 3, 2003. The child has resided her entire life in Granville County, North Carolina. She attends school in Granville County.

6. The Defendant, William Scott Morris, has physical custody of the minor child, Carolyn Haley Morris and is residing with his parents, the plaintiffs, in Creedmoor, Granville County, North Carolina.

7. The minor child resided with Kelly Currin Morris and the Defendant, William Scott Morris in Granville County, North Carolina from the time of her birth until approximately June of 2006, when the Defendants and the child, together with Taylor Brogden, the child's half-sister, lived with the Intervenor, Carlton Patrick Currin and Juanita P. Currin until January, 2007. From January 2007 until September 3, 2008, the minor child resided with the defendants until Kelly Currin Morris's disappearance. During all relevant times, Kelly Currin Morris was the primary caretaker.

8. Pursuant to N.C.G.S. § 50-A-201(a), North Carolina is the "home state" for the minor child of the parties, and this Court has jurisdiction to enter orders for child custody.

9. Pursuant to N.C.G.S. § 50-13 et al., Intervenor bring this claim in good faith and they have not participated as parties, witnesses, or in any other capacity in any other litigation concerning the custody of said minor child in this or any other State.

10. The Intervenor have no information of any custody proceeding concerning the minor child pending in a Court of this or any other State.

11. The Intervenor inform the court that the natural maternal grandmother of the minor child, Wanda W. Hollis, of Orange County, North Carolina is a person who may have visitation rights with respect to said minor child.

12. The minor child's family is not intact and the Intervenor has standing to seek the relief requested herein.

13. The Intervenor's daughter, Kelly Currin Morris disappeared and has not been seen since the evening of September 3, 2008. She failed to report to work on September 4, 2008. She has been identified as a "Missing Person."

14. On the morning of September 4, 2008 the house owned and occupied by the Defendant and Kelly Currin Morris at 3220 Tump Wilkins Rd., Stem, North Carolina was discovered to be on fire. Investigators have ruled the house fire as arson.

15. Kelly Currin Morris' vehicle was found abandoned approximately one mile from the house with her purse, cell phone and keys locked inside.

16. Upon information and belief, Kelly Currin Morris is a victim of homicide.

17. The Defendant William Scott Morris was named a "person of interest" in the pending investigation according to Granville County Sheriff David Smith.

18. On September 25, 2008 a Search Warrant issued "In the Matter of William Scott Morris" was filed in the Office of the Clerk of Superior Court of Granville County. In the application for the Search Warrant attached thereto North Carolina SBI Agent Brian Fleming recited certain facts indicating that the Defendant lied to the investigators regarding his whereabouts and activities during the evening hours of September 3, 2008 and the morning of September 4, 2008. Based upon the facts and circumstances as set forth in said application the Intervenor believe that William Scott Morris was involved in the disappearance of Kelly Currin Morris and the arson of the residence and was untruthful to investigators of the Granville County Sheriff's Department and the North Carolina State Bureau of Investigation.

19. Specifically, the Defendant, William Scott Morris, told investigators that Kelly had left the home at approximately 9:30 p.m. on the evening of September 3, 2008 to look for a missing dog, and that he had taken a shower, gone directly to bed and slept through the night. Telephone records revealed a series of calls between the Defendant and his father, Jimmy Morris from approximately 9:45 p.m. to midnight. Jimmy Morris told investigators that the Defendant called him at approximately 10:00 p.m. and asked him to come babysit while his son went to look for Kelly. The Defendant told his father that he believed that Kelly was cheating on him. Jimmy Morris was not truthful in his statements regarding the time of a later call from the Defendant to him or the time that the Defendant arrived back at the residence.

20. The Defendant told investigators that on the morning of Thursday, September 4, 2008 he drove straight from Scott's storage lot in Butner to Hardee's and then from Hardee's "straight" to the BP Station on Main St. in Creedmoor. Video cameras in the area revealed that the Defendant traveled to Hardee's and left Hardee's along West Lyon Station Rd. which is the direction of his residence. This was in the time period prior to the discovery of the fire at the residence.

21. Someone went to the house and released the dogs before the fire was discovered. The dogs were locked in dog crates in the house when the Defendant and the children left the residence earlier that morning.

22. During the months prior to Kelly Currin Morris' disappearance, the Defendant engaged in a pattern of emotional abuse directed toward Kelly and both of her children. According to the affidavit of Brian Fleming the Defendant had "punched holes in the wall during arguments and once threw a computer out of a window".

23. Based upon information and belief, William Scott Morris is the primary suspect in the disappearance of his wife, Kelly Currin Morris, and may be arrested on charges related to her disappearance at anytime. It will not be in the best interest of the minor child for her to be present when this occurs. Based upon the facts and circumstances set out in the Search Warrant application there is at least some probability that Jimmy Morris, the father of the Defendant, with whom the Defendant is residing, was also involved in Kelly's disappearance.

24. On information and belief, the Defendant is mentally and emotionally unstable and is acting in a manner inconsistent with his obligation as a parent and the minor child should not be subjected to the risks inherent in being in his custody.

25. The minor child, Carolyn Haley Morris, is presently exposed to a substantial risk of harm and bodily injury when in the Defendant's care and that there is a substantial risk that the child may be removed by the Defendant from the State of North Carolina for the purpose of evading the jurisdiction of North Carolina Courts.

26. The Intervenor, Carlton Patrick Currin is the maternal grandfather of the minor child, Carolyn Haley Morris. The Intervenor, Juanita Currin is the maternal step-grandmother of said child. The Intervenor, Carlton Patrick Currin, Jr., is the maternal uncle of the child.

27. The Intervenor are fit and proper persons to have the care, custody and control of the minor child and it is in the best interest and welfare of the minor child that the Court grant the Intervenor temporary and permanent legal and physical custody of the minor child. The Intervenor love the minor child and have assisted in her care on a regular basis since her birth.

28. The minor child, Carolyn Haley Morris loves the Intervenor and calls them "Papa" and "Granny" and has spent numerous overnights with them.

29. Until September 3, 2008, the minor child resided with her half-sister, Taylor Brogden, age 8. The children have been separated since the disappearance of their mother, and the Intervenor provide a loving home where the girls can be together. Taylor and Haley attend the same school in Granville County. The only time they see each other is at the home of the Intervenor and school.

30. The Intervenor have a close relationship with Craig Brogden who is the father of Haley's sister, Taylor and since Kelly's disappearance the Intervenor have arranged on occasion for Haley and Taylor to spend time together.

31. The continued separation of Haley from her sister Taylor is causing Haley substantial emotional distress.

32. The Intervenor has arranged for Haley and Taylor to have professional counseling to assist them with dealing with the loss of their Mother but that the Defendant has not cooperated in Haley's participation in counseling.

33. The Intervenor, Carlton Patrick Currin is the owner and operator of a construction business and the Intervenor, Juanita P. Currin is a registered nurse.

34. That based on information and belief, William Scott Morris is not fit to be the custodian for the minor child.

35. Based on information and belief, the plaintiffs, Jimmy and Carolyn Morris are grandparents of the child entitled to appropriate visitation with the child as the court sees fit.

**MOTION TO VACATE TEMPORARY CONSENT ORDER
AND FOR EMERGENCY TEMPORARY CUSTODY**

36. The allegations contained in Paragraphs 1 through 35 above are incorporated herein by reference.

37. The Intervenor move that the Court strike the Temporary Order entered on November 24, 2008, and enter an Emergency Temporary Custody Order vesting legal and physical custody of the minor child to the Intervenor.

38. There is a substantial risk that the minor child is exposed to a substantial risk of injury and further emotional distress in the Defendant's custody and she may be removed from the State of North Carolina by Defendant for the purpose of evading the jurisdiction of North Carolina courts.

WHEREFORE, the Intervenor pray that the Court:

1. That this verified Answer and Counterclaim of the Intervenor be allowed and taken as an Affidavit in support of Intervenor's application and claim for temporary and permanent child custody, and that said Answer and Counterclaim also be allowed and taken as an Affidavit upon which to base all Orders, whether temporary, ex parte or otherwise, of this Court; and

2. That the Court order this action removed to a proper venue pursuant to the Intervenor's separate Motion to Remove filed herein; and

3. That the Court vacate the temporary custody order filed herein on November 25, 2008; and


4. That the Court grant Intervenor's Motion for Emergency Temporary Custody; and

7. For such other and further relief as the court deems just and proper.


