Probable Cause Affidavit

I, Senior Officer E.J. Sweden, have been a sworn member of the Raleigh Police Department since June, 2000 and am currently assigned to the Raleigh Police Department Crash Reconstruction Unit. I am tasked with investigating serious injury and fatal crashes. I have been involved in investigating over 60 fatal traffic crashes and over 100 serious injury crashes since being assigned to this unit three years ago. I have investigated over 1,000 traffic collisions as a law enforcement officer.

I have received advanced traffic crash investigation and crash reconstruction training at Wilson Technical Community College, Wilson, North Carolina and the Institute of Police Technology and Management, Jacksonville, Florida. I have been qualified as an expert in the area of traffic crash reconstruction and impaired driving investigation. I also teach police officers in how to conduct and interpret both traffic crash investigation and impaired driving investigations.

While reviewing documents from initial responding officers, witnesses to the crash and EMS workers it appears that Mr. Cook showed obvious signs of impairment to include a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from his person and being unsteady on his feet, actually bumping into people and objects as well as red, glassy and bloodshot eyes. Blood was collected from Mr. Cook nearly two hours after the collision and sent to the SBI for analysis. Results from the SBI indicate Mr. Cook had an alcohol concentration of 0.19 after the collision occurred.

Officer's investigating the crash scene located a black iPhone on the driver side floorboard and logged that phone into evidence at the Raleigh Police Department. A witness statement taken in the course of this investigation reveals that Mr. Cook made a spontaneous statement which leads me to believe that Mr. Cook may have been on the phone either at the time of the crash or just prior to the crash.

I conducted several interviews relating to a fatal car crash at Strickland Road at Lead Mine Road. In conducting interviews at Pipers Tavern on Falls of the Neuse Road, Raleigh, North Carolina I learned that Raymond Cook had been at Pipers Tavern shortly before the crash. Several interviews reveal that Mr. Cook showed signs of being impaired not only when he left Pipers Tavern but when he arrived. I also learned that Mr. Cook was in the company of a fernale while at Pipers Tavern, but Mr. Cook did not have a passenger in his vehicle at the time of the crash.

I also learned during the course of the investigation that Mr. Cook may have been at the Raleigh Country Club just prior to arriving at Pipers Tavern.

Conclusion

Based upon the information contained in this affidavit, I believe that probable cause exists to search the iPhone possessed by Mr. Cook, telephone number 919-200-2004. I also believe that information contained in Mr. Cook's cellular telephone will contain information in the form of telephone calls made and received; text messages sent and received; email's and potentially Global Position Satellite data which will all aid in determining Mr. Cook's locations on the day of this fatal crash to determine where Mr. Cook obtained and consumed alcohol as well as assist in identifying any person or persons who Mr. Cook was with prior to this event.
