## FACTS TO ESTABLISH PROBABLE CAUSE:

1. I, S Selvek, have been a duly sworn law enforcement officer in Garner for the past eleven years. I have been employed with the Garner Police Department since 1997. I am currently assigned to the Drugs and Vice Unit. I have received specialized training in the area of criminal investigations and have 1800 hours of Law Enforcement related training. This training was conducted through numerous Community Colleges, the North Carolina Justice Academy, and numerous Federal Agencies. As a result of this training, I am familiar the numerous areas of Law Enforcement and utilize the knowledge to investigate criminal acts.

Since being a Garner Police Investigator, April 2004, I have also investigated murders, rapes, robberies, assault cases, other criminal cases, and some of these cases resulted in arrests and convictions.

2. On 11-14-08 around 2217 hours, Officers with the Garner Police Department discovered the body of a deceased child located at 1852 Spring Drive Garner N.C. 27529. The apartment is leased to Sherita McNeil, the mother of the deceased child. Through investigative means it was discovered that the utilities to that location were in the name of Eric Chambers, the father of the deceased child. The child was found in a white plastic garbage bag, in a plastic container with sheets on top, and the sheets had bleach poured on them to mask the smell. This container was located in the bedroom closet of Sherita McNeil. The child had not been seen by family members for over a month. The mother told family members that the child was staying with a close family friend when, in fact, the child was not.
