- Up 36 percent in 1st
 Quarter
- Driven by increase in aggravated assaults

 Quarter
- Increases in larcenies and burglaries

Part 1 Index Crime

- Total of property and violent crime
- Part 1 index crime up 13 percent in 1st quarter from 2013
- Driven by increases in burglaries and aggravated assaults

Priority 1 Call Response Time

- 1,099 Priority 1 calls from January 1, 2014 to March 31, 2014
- 6.1 minute average response time – Target is 5.8 minutes
- 51.7% under 5 minutes –
 Does not meet target of 57%
