# Part 1 Violent Crime



- Homicides, rapes, aggravated assaults and robberies
- Up 36 percent in 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter
- Driven by increase in aggravated assaults

# Part 1 Property Crime



- Burglary, Larceny and Motor Vehicle Theft
- Up 10 percent in 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter
- Increases in larcenies and burglaries

## **Part 1 Index Crime**

- **Total of property and violent crime**
- **Part 1 index crime up 13 percent in 1<sup>st</sup> quarter from 2013**
- **Driven by increases in burglaries and aggravated assaults**

## **Priority 1 Call Response Time**

- **1,099 Priority 1 calls from January 1, 2014 to March 31, 2014**
- **6.1 minute average response time – Target is 5.8 minutes**
- **51.7% under 5 minutes – Does not meet target of 57%**
