



CASE SUMMARY

THIS IS THE CASE OF A 33 YEAR OLD CAUCASIAN FEMALE, POLICE OFFICER AT BALD HEAD ISLAND, NORTH CAROLINA, WHO WAS FOUND DEAD WITH A GUNSHOT WOUND TO THE HEAD.

EXAMINATION OF THIS GUNSHOT WOUND REVEALED THAT IT WAS LOCATED ON THE BACK OF THE HEAD IN THE POSTERIOR MIDLINE. THERE WAS SPLITTING OF THE UNDERLYING SKIN AS WELL AS POWDER ON THE UNDERLYING BONE, INDICATING THAT THE RANGE OF THIS SHOT WAS HARD CONTACT. THE DIRECTION OF THIS MISSILE THROUGH THE HEAD WAS FORWARD AND UPWARD. A SEVERELY NOSE DEFORMED, METAL JACKETED, HOLLOW POINT LEAD PROJECTILE OF APPROXIMATELY .40 CALIBER WAS RECOVERED.

THE ONLY OTHER FINDINGS WERE HEAVY DEPOSITS OF BLOOD ON THE BACKS OF BOTH THE DECEDENT'S HANDS, THE RIGHT GREATER THAN THE LEFT. HER FINGERNALLS WERE INTACT AS WAS HER CLOTHING. THERE WAS NO EVIDENCE OF A STRUGGLE. NO NATURALLY OCCURRING DISEASE PROCESSES WERE NOTED.

TOXICOLOGICAL ANALYSIS OF THE POST MORTEM BLOOD SAMPLE REVEALED THE COCAINE, ETHANOL AND MORPHINE TO BE NONE DETECTED.

IT IS MY OPINION THAT THIS WOMAN. CAME TO HER DEATH AS THE RESULT OF THIS HARD CONTACT RANGE GUNSHOT WOUND TO THE BACK OF HER HEAD AND FROM NO OTHER CAUSE.
