Dear Mr. Reisinger:

This letter is to follow up on our telephone conversations yesterday concerning marriage license applications from same-sex couples you expected to receive today. It is my understanding that you have now received these applications and that it is your intent to hold them pending advice from this office.

As we discussed, North Carolina law presently prohibits the issuance of a marriage license to same-sex couples. A lawsuit has been filed challenging the constitutionality of North Carolina's law in view of recent decisions by the United States Supreme Court. The courts will ultimately decide whether North Carolina's prohibition of same-sex marriages is constitutional. Unless the courts rule otherwise or North Carolina law is changed, issuance of a marriage license to a same-sex couple would be a violation of the law.
