


<u>Description of Property to be Seized</u>
Property to be seized will include evidence and ownership, possession and/or occupancy of the residence located at 4716 Par Vista Court Raleigh, North Carolina; documents that include names, addresses, phone numbers, etc., of friends, family and associates; trace evidence to include blood, latent prints, hairs, fibers, DNA, or similar evidence; clothing worn by the perpetrator; information maintained in any cellular telephone, pager, computer, or electronic data; firearms, bullets, shell casings, projectiles, gun magazines, or any other possible weapons or trace evidence associated with or used in the commission of this incident; and any other evidence related to this attempted suicide.
<u>Description of Premises to be Searched</u>
The residence to be searched is a two-story, single family dwelling located at 4716 Par Vista Court in Raleigh, North Carolina. The structure has an exterior covering of cream-colored siding accented with black shutters. The numbers "4716" are affixed to the door jamb beside the front door.

Probable Cause Affidavit

I, Detective K. M. Norman of the Raleigh Police Department, have been employed as a law enforcement officer for more than 16 years. During that time I have been exposed to, investigated and successfully obtained convictions for numerous types of offenses and crimes that include rape, robbery, violent assaults, and homicides. I am currently assigned as a detective with the department's Homicide Unit where I conduct death and homicide investigations. I am familiar that evidence of both physical and forensic nature is often recovered at crimes scenes.

On Thursday 01/27/2011 at approximately 7:00 p.m., detectives with the Raleigh Police Department were conducting a follow-up investigation at the residence located at 4716 Par Vista Court. During that investigation, the detectives were conducting an interview with a male occupant of the residence. A uniformed officer responded to the residence in order to transport the male occupant to a police facility for further investigation. While making preparations to leave the residence, the male occupant retrieved a firearm and engaged in a stand-off with the uniformed officer. During that stand-off, the male occupant shot himself in the head.

I believe probable cause exists to conduct a search at 4716 Par Vista Court Raleigh, North Carolina. It is requested this search warrant be issued in order to seize any and all evidence related to this incident.
