


- 2.) On September 1<sup>st</sup>, 2010, Avery Green came to the Wake County Sheriff's Office to report his brother, David R. Green, Jr. as a missing person. Avery Green said he had not heard from his brother in a very long time. The family lost contact with David Green, Jr. in December of 2008.
- 3.) Avery Green reported his mother, Zeddie Green, received a phone call from a concerned neighbor of David R. Green, Jr. The neighbor stated the house at 8617 Ray Rd. was falling into disrepair. The lawn was grown up and the area around the residence had not been kept to normal standards. Allen White, a neighbor of David Green, Jr.'s, relayed to Avery Green he had witnessed suspicious activity around the home in the last six months but had not seen the homeowner, David Green, Jr.
- 4.) Avery Green came to check on his brother on or about August 25<sup>th</sup>, 2010. He found the residence at 8617 Ray Rd., Raleigh NC appeared to have been abandoned. The grass had grown up and electric service to the home was not in service. Avery Green described his brother as being well kept and someone who kept his yard and house in good condition.
- 5.) A missing person investigation was initiated as a result of the information reported by Avery Green. Inv. Bell with the Wake County Sheriff's Office began to follow up on the case. David R. Green, Jr. was entered as a missing person into NCIC on September 2, 2010.
- 6.) An interview was conducted with neighbor Allen White on September 7<sup>th</sup>, 2010. Mr. White reported he had not seen David R. Green, Jr. in several months.
- 7.) On October 6, 2010, Inv. Bell met with Avery Green at 8617 Ray Rd., Raleigh, NC. Avery Green provided consent for a cursory search of the residence. Avery Green has a key to the residence and was acting at the request of his mother, Zeddie Green. During the cursory search of the residence, a freezer was located in the basement area. The freezer was opened revealing what appeared to be a human body inside. Inv. Bell observed what appeared to be human remains, which were partially covered by a type of wrapping. Inv. Bell stated she observed what appeared to be knees and a torso. The house was vacated and secured pending further investigation.
- 8.) The above facts were presented to Superior Court Judge Rand on October 6, 2010 and a search warrant was issued for the residence of 8617 Ray Rd., Raleigh, NC 27613. Investigators with the Wake County Sheriff's Office and City County Bureau of Identification began a search of the residence at 8617 Ray Rd., Raleigh, NC. During the initial moments of the search, Investigators went to the basement area of the residence. They opened a freezer located in a closet area and confirmed human remains were present.

- 9.) Investigators consulted the North Carolina Office of the Chief Medical Examiner to coordinate efforts for removal and identification of the remains. Based on the recommendations of the medical examiner, the human remains were removed with the freezer from 8617 Ray Rd., Raleigh, NC and transported to the Medical Examiner's Office in Chapel Hill, NC.


- 1.) This affiant is a Senior Investigator for the Wake County Sheriff's Office. I have approximately 12 years of law enforcement experience. I am currently employed with the Wake County Sheriff's Office where I have served for over eight years. I have worked as a judicial services deputy, patrol deputy and investigator. I am currently assigned to the Criminal Investigative Division-Person Crimes Unit where I investigate all types of crimes. These crimes include but are not limited to murder, suicide, rape, assault, arson and armed robbery. Throughout my employment, I have received and continue to receive specialized training through seminars and schools dealing with the above crimes. I have attended specialized training in the area of death investigation, suicide investigation and fire investigation. I have received over one thousand hours of in various areas and disciplines of law enforcement. I make this affidavit based on my personal knowledge together with information I have received from other persons I believe to be credible.
- 2.) On September 1<sup>st</sup>, 2010, Avery Green came to the Wake County Sheriff's Office to report his brother, David R. Green Jr. as a missing person. Avery Green said he had not heard from his brother in a very long time. The family lost contact with David Green Jr. in December of 2008. David Green Jr., was last known to reside at 8617 Ray Rd., Raleigh NC 27613. The property records of Wake County indicate David Green Jr. as the owner of the residence of 8617 Ray Rd., Raleigh NC.
- 3.) Avery Green reported his mother, Zeddie Green, received a phone call from a concerned neighbor of David R. Green Jr. The neighbor stated the house at 8617 Ray Rd. was falling into disrepair. The lawn was grown up and the area around the residence had not been kept to normal standards. Allen White, (neighbor) relayed to Avery Green he had witnessed suspicious activity around the home in the last six months but had not seen the homeowner, David Green Jr.
- 4.) Avery Green came to check on his brother on or about August 25<sup>th</sup>, 2010. He found the residence at 8617 Ray Rd., Raleigh NC. He found the home to appear abandoned. The grass had grown up and electric service to the home was not in service. Avery described his brother as being well kept and someone who kept his yard and house in good condition.
- 5.) A missing person investigation was initiated as a result of the information reported by Avery Green. Inv. Bell with the Wake County Sheriff's Office began to follow up on the case. David R. Green Jr. was entered as a missing person into NCIC on September 2, 2010.
- 6.) An interview was conducted with neighbor Allen White on September 7<sup>th</sup>, 2010. Mr. White reported he had not seen David R. Green Jr. since the spring.




