I have received training in crimes through the North Carolina Justice Academy, Raleigh Police Department's Academy, and regularly scheduled in-service training sessions dealing with laws of arrest, search and seizure, interviewing, the preparation of a search warrant and criminal investigation. I have conducted investigations that have led to the arrest and conviction of individuals for violations of North Carolina general statutes. I have obtained and executed numerous search warrants in the past that have led to the arrest and conviction of suspects.

On March 6, 2010 at approximately 11:48 am the Raleigh Police Department responded to 2710 Cartier Dr. Raleigh, NC in reference to an assault and rape. This address is within the city limits of Raleigh, NC and falls in the jurisdictional boundaries of the Raleigh Police Department. The investigation revealed that the victim had been sexually assaulted. The injuries inflicted upon the victim resulted in the victim's death. Therefore, this case is being investigated as a homicide.

On April 16, 2010 probable cause was established for the issuance of arrest warrants for Jason Keith Williford w/m/12-10-79 for the offenses of murder and rape in regards to this investigation. Those warrants were served the same day and Jason Keith Williford was arrested for these charges. During the course of the investigation a search warrant was obtained for Jason Keith Williford's w/m/12-10-79 residence located at 2812-D Wayland Dr. Raleigh, NC. During the execution of that search warrant two computers were seized in accordance with the search warrant. This search warrant is requested to search the computers for possible evidence related to this homicide investigation.

In the course of this investigation, I spoke with Detective Brown of the Raleigh Police Department Cyber Crimes Unit. Detective Brown investigates crimes related to the use of Computers and/or Computer systems. He has received training in the field of computer system seizures and computer forensic analysis.

Detective Brown told me that computer hardware, peripheral components, software, documentation, passwords and data security devices may be important to a criminal investigation in two distinct and important respects:

- 1. the objects themselves may be instrumentalities, fruits, or evidence of the crime, and/or
- 2. the objects may have been used to collect and store information about crimes in the form of electronic data.

From my own personal experience, and the information provided to me by Detective Brown, I know that users of computers often save information or create documents to storage devices, and forensic examinations that have been conducted on other computer systems, in other unrelated investigations, have revealed data or information that connected the computer system/storage devices to criminal activity.

Therefore it is my opinion that a forensic examination of the seized computers and media referred to above may reveal evidence related to the murder of Kathy Taft. This evidence may include the following:

1. Digital files that show visits to internet sites or collection of photographs which depict sexual assault.
