



PROBABLE CAUSE: I, A.B. Miller, have been a duly sworn law enforcement officer in Wake County for the past seven years. I was employed with the Garner Police Department in 2001. I have received specialized training in investigations. This training was conducted through Wake Technical Community College and North Carolina Justice Academy. As a result of my experience and training, I am familiar with assaults, motor vehicle deaths, and the appearance of controlled substances and packaging materials.

I have in the course of my duties, investigated assaults, motor vehicle wrecks, and drug violations. I have seized controlled substances and arrested persons for violations of the North Carolina Controlled Substances Act. I have also arrested persons involved in assaults and motor vehicle violations. These arrests have resulted in convictions.

On 02/17/09 around 0331 hrs. Garner Police and EMS responded to a passing motorist's call of a female unconscious on the shoulder of Aversboro Rd. near Old Scarborough Ln. The unidentified female sustained a head injury and was transported by EMS to Wake Med Raleigh where she is in critical condition. A pill bottle was located in her pocket with the name of Mayela Orduna written on it. The phone number to the doctor's office was out of Texas. Investigators were able to locate a possible address for Orduna. I requested that the Ellis County Sheriff's Department (Texas) send a deputy out to the possible address to attempt to locate a family member of Orduna's. The employee has proven that he/she is familiar with what marijuana looks like and how marijuana is packaged and smells.

PROBABLE CAUSE CONTINUED


