

RESIDENTIAL PARKING PERMITS

- Residential parking permits are available to residents in Controlled Parking Residential Areas.
- These may be obtained at the Park Raleigh office at 131 South Wilmington St.
- There is a permit issuance fee of \$10 per decal payable at the time of issuance.
- Eligibility for a permit requires documentation showing name and address such as; utility bills, notarized affidavits of the landlord, auto registration, etc.
- Those parking without a permit in a Controlled Parking Residential Area are limited to 2 hours during posted periods.

PARKING FACILITIES RATES

Free parking on street and in most City parking decks weekdays 7:00 p.m. - 7:00 a.m. and on weekends.

AVOIDING PARKING VIOLATIONS

- What is the citation rate for meter and time zone violations? \$15.
- Is there a required distance to park from a driveway? Yes, at least five (5) feet from the entrance to a private or public driveway.
- How long can I park at a loading zone? Parking during loading is limited to one hour in signed loading zones.
- Can I use a Commercial Loading Zone? Commercial Loading Zones are restricted to Commercially registered vehicles.
- Can I re-feed the parking meter? No. Metered parking spaces are intended to meet short-term parking needs. Re-feeding meters is a violation.
- How close can I park to a fire hydrant? Vehicles may not park within 15 feet of a fire hydrant.
- How close can I park to a cross-walk? Vehicles may not park within 12 feet of a cross-walk.
- Why was my vehicle booted? Vehicles with three (3) or more delinquent (older than 90 days) tickets or outstanding penalty amounts are subject to booting.
- Parking in a reserved space is subject to a \$25 fine.

CITATION APPEAL PROCESS

- If you feel that you have received a parking citation in error, you may submit a Request for Citation Dismissal form to Park Raleigh.
- These forms are available on the Park Raleigh website and by calling Park Raleigh at 919-828-1020.
- Park Raleigh can send this via email, fax and mail.
- The appeals process is simple and quick and consists of three levels:
 1. An Administrative Review of the citation
 2. An Administrative Hearing with a neutral mediator (the citation must be paid prior to scheduling a hearing)
 3. Wake County Superior Court
- Invalid reasons for appeal:
 1. Lack of knowledge of the City's parking regulations.
 2. Appointment conflicts or tardiness going or returning from appointments.
 3. Inability to find a legal parking space.

DOWNTOWN RALEIGH PARKING MAP LEGEND

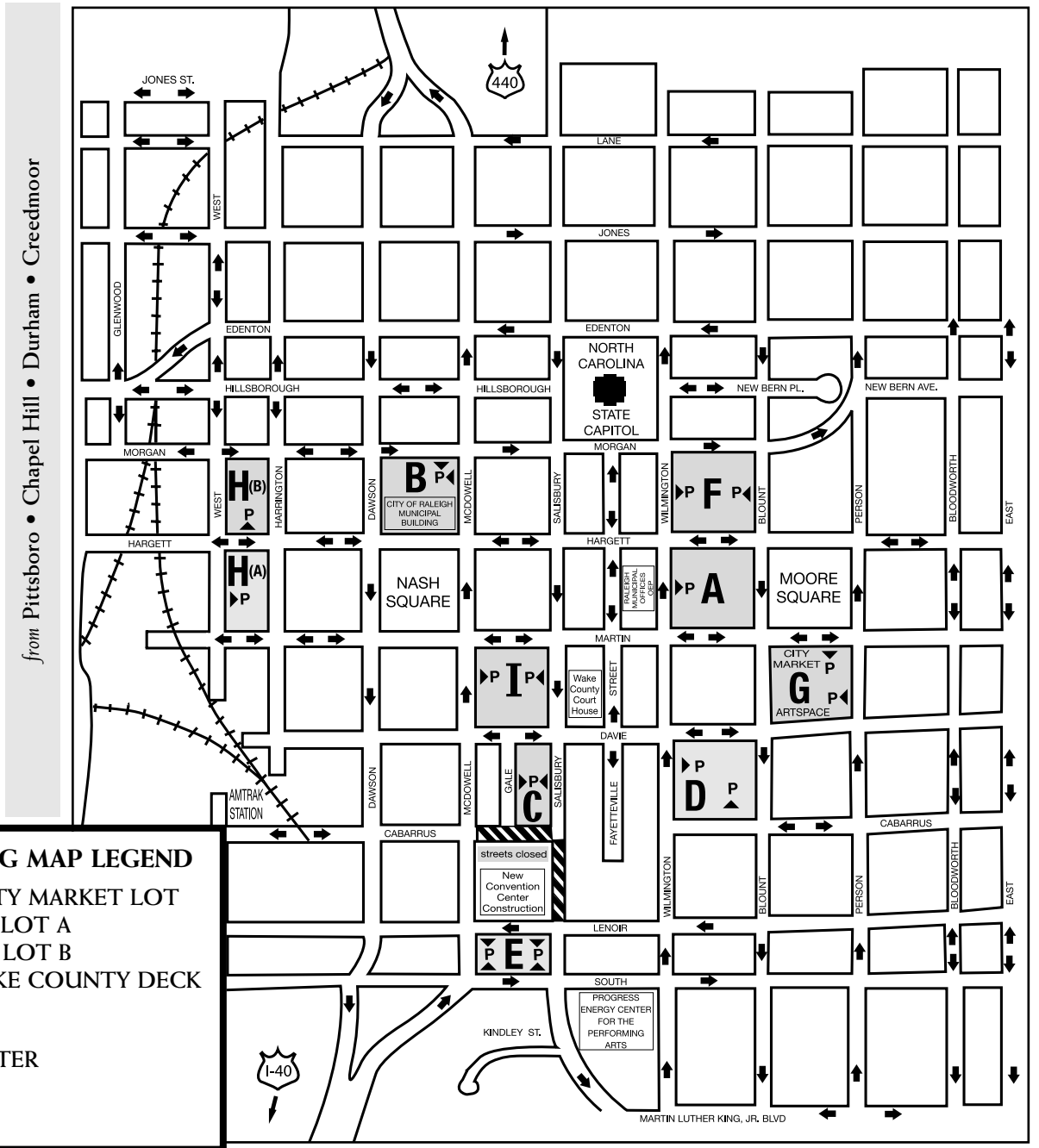
