In addition, I seek to review overpayment claims established by the Texas Health and Human Services Commission from 2009 through 2013 because of fraud or intentional program violation (IPV).

If the data already are stored as structured data, I request that I be allowed to review the data in a format allows them to be imported into standard database or spreadsheet software. Examples include an Excel .xls or .xlsx file, an Access .mdb or .accdb file or a text-based delimited file.

I do not seek any identifying information such as name, street address or date of birth of anyone who may have received overpayment notices.
