- With any severe weather event, we put safety and the safety of the crews first.
- We monitored the storm for as long as it had been developing. Once it entered the Gulf of Mexico, we closely followed the projected path, intensity and timing of Hurricane Beryl for several days. Despite the varying forecasts and predictions as to where it was going to make landfall and what it would do inland, we prepared for our service area and customers to be impacted.
- We requested substantial mutual assistance support before the storm made landfall. After they made their preparations for an extended response, they were

support before the storm made landfall. After they made their preparations for an extended response, they were on their way from other parts of the country to support our restoration efforts. These crews were positioned in nearby locations so they would be safe when the storm hit.

- As the storm intensified on Monday, we made plans for even more mutual assistance resources. As of this morning, we have 12,000 field resources to support the restoration efforts.
- As soon as it was safe to do so yesterday, we released crews into the field to begin the restoration process.
