

1 P.O.GILMORE: It was uh a call that came over the radio,  
2 yes.

3

4 KILLEN: Okay so that time you guys, when you hear it on  
5 the radio do you know where you were at?

6 P.O.GILMORE: Um, I was in the area of 64<sup>th</sup> and Normal.

7

8 KILLEN: Do you know where the actual shots fired was at?

9 P.O.GILMORE: Um, just from what gang guys said on the  
10 radio it sounded like it was coming I believe  
11 west of 65<sup>th</sup> and Green, if I remember correctly.

12

13 KILLEN: Okay so you and Officer Schmidt then head over to  
14 65, towards 65<sup>th</sup> and Green I guess?

15 P.O.GILMORE: Into that area until we were directed by the  
16 citizens to go further south and west.

17

18 KILLEN: Okay so then you ended up, do you, do you know  
19 which (inaudible) where you were at? To get to,  
20 what route did you take to get to 66<sup>th</sup> and South  
21 Sangamon?

22 P.O.GILMORE: I don't, I don't remember the exact route.  
23 We went west from 64<sup>th</sup> and Normal. I prob'ly shot  
24 down 64<sup>th</sup> west um towards Green, Morgan area.  
25 Then that's when we were flagged down by the  
26 people who were tellin' us it was south and west  
27 of there. So I headed south towards 66<sup>th</sup> and I  
28 think that's when we heard Kevin callin' it out  
29 that he was chasin' a guy over there. And then  
30 that's when Rich pointed out the guy that was  
31 runnin'.

32

1 KILLEN: So at that point are you on 66<sup>th</sup> Street?  
2 P.O.GILMORE: I'm on 66<sup>th</sup> Street goin' westbound.  
3  
4 KILLEN: Okay and you're approachin' Sangamon?  
5 P.O.GILMORE: Sangamon.  
6  
7 KILLEN: Okay. And you hear Officer Paruskiewicz over the  
8 radio sayin' he's chasin' this guy?  
9 P.O.GILMORE: Yes.  
10  
11 KILLEN: Did he say he was chasin' this guy on foot? Or  
12 on the car? Do you know?  
13 P.O.GILMORE: I don't remember.  
14  
15 KILLEN: Okay. Were you the driver or passenger?  
16 P.O.GILMORE: I was the driver.  
17  
18 KILLEN: Okay. So then as your, as you're travelin'  
19 westbound now on 66<sup>th</sup> Street now you already know  
20 that uh Officer Paruskiewicz is um, is chasin'  
21 this guy. Do you, do you remember, had they  
22 given a description of the guy he's chasin'?  
23 P.O.GILMORE: I don't remember. I was driving so I it's  
24 just my thing. I like to work the lights so I  
25 can't hear anything over my radio. I count on  
26 Rich to tell me the direction and the  
27 description.  
28  
29 KILLEN: Okay. So, since you're going westbound then you  
30 hear Rich then say there he is?  
31 P.O.GILMORE: Yes.  
32

1 KILLEN: Okay and do you see who he's talkin' about at  
2 that point?

3 P.O.GILMORE: No I saw who I believe is Kevin in, at the  
4 mouth of the alley (inaudible)  
5

6 KILLEN: Did you know Kevin before tonight?

7 P.O.GILMORE: I worked with 'em yeah.  
8

9 KILLEN: Okay so you would've recognized him had you seen  
10 'em?

11 P.O.GILMORE: I saw a white guy in a vest and I figured it  
12 was Kevin cuz he was chasin' and callin' out so I  
13 figured that's who it was.  
14

15 KILLEN: Okay.

16 P.O.GILMORE: But from where I was I couldn't see his  
17 face.  
18

19 KILLEN: The first person you see that's not inside your  
20 squad car is Kevin Paruskiewicz correct?

21 P.O.GILMORE: A white police officer who I thought was  
22 Kevin.  
23

24 KILLEN: Okay. And it eventually ends up being Kevin  
25 Paruskiewicz?

26 P.O.GILMORE: I believe it was Kevin yeah.  
27

28 KILLEN: Okay. Was he and he's comin' outta the mouth of  
29 the alley?

30 P.O.GILMORE: He was at the mouth of the alley.  
31

1 KILLEN: All right and, and which alley are we talkin'  
2 about?

3 P.O.GILMORE: It would be the west alley of 66<sup>th</sup> and  
4 Sangamon.  
5

6 KILLEN: Okay. And that's the alley between Sangamon and  
7 Morgan?

8 P.O.GILMORE: I should know this but I, I can't think of  
9 what the street west of Sangamon is.  
10

11 KILLEN: Okay so, so and he's at the mouth. Do you see uh  
12 the offender Wesley?

13 P.O.GILMORE: Uh Rich points him out. He says the guy  
14 wearin' the white shorts running down the street.  
15

16 KILLEN: Runnin' down the street is what street we talkin'  
17 'bout?

18 P.O.GILMORE: He's on Sangamon on the west side of the  
19 street.  
20

21 KILLEN: And which way is he goin'?

22 P.O.GILMORE: He's goin' south.  
23

24 KILLEN: And he okay so he's running south on, southbound  
25 on Sangamon.

26 P.O.GILMORE: On the west side of Sangamon.  
27

28 KILLEN: Is he on the sidewalk or is he on the street?

29 P.O.GILMORE: He's on the sidewalk.  
30

31 KILLEN: All right. How far behind him is Officer  
32 Paruskiewicz? If, if you could guess?

1 P.O.GILMORE: Kevin's still at the mouth of the alley. So  
2 if I had to estimate I'm guessing uh 75 feet  
3 maybe. Half of a city block.  
4  
5 KILLEN: Okay. So whaddayou, whadda you do at that point?  
6 P.O.GILMORE: I just jam on the gas and I turn south onto  
7 Sangamon (inaudible)  
8  
9 KILLEN: Okay so when you do that he's still on the  
10 sidewalk?  
11 P.O.GILMORE: He's on the sidewalk.  
12  
13 KILLEN: He's still goin', runnin' south?  
14 P.O.GILMORE: He's still runnin' south.  
15  
16 KILLEN: And what happens?  
17 P.O.GILMORE: Um, we finally catch up to 'em, um, to the  
18 point where I'm in front of him and I wanted to  
19 cut 'em off. So uh I was in my truck, I pointed  
20 it south and west um, in the street, in the  
21 middle of the street and I told Rich to get out.  
22 Rich got out and he started chasin' the guy on  
23 foot. When I saw that the guy double back, I  
24 thought Rich was gonna be able to grab 'em. So  
25 the guy double backed so I jumped outta my truck  
26 and I start givin' chase.  
27  
28 KILLEN: And when you saw double back, can you explain  
29 that?  
30 P.O.GILMORE: Yeah, he, he started runnin' back northbound  
31 from the direction he came from.  
32

1 KILLEN: So he just about face and ran?  
2 P.O.GILMORE: Yeah.  
3  
4 KILLEN: Ran back where he came.  
5 P.O.GILMORE: Yeah.  
6  
7 KILLEN: All right so you get out, all right and whadda  
8 you do?  
9 P.O.GILMORE: When I get out I started chasin' after 'em.  
10  
11 KILLEN: Are you a, are you runnin' on the sidewalk behind  
12 'em or --  
13 P.O.GILMORE: I'm in the street.  
14  
15 KILLEN: All right and I take it he's still on the  
16 sidewalk when he double backs?  
17 P.O.GILMORE: When he double back he was on the sidewalk  
18 then he ran across the street to the east side of  
19 the street.  
20  
21 KILLEN: Okay. And what happens from there?  
22 P.O.GILMORE: Um, Rich chases 'em onto the sidewalk. I'm  
23 still in the street. (clears throat) Then he  
24 comes back uh across me into the street again.  
25  
26 KILLEN: Which sidewalk, is he still does he cross in the  
27 street like goin' sidewalk to sidewalk?  
28 P.O.GILMORE: He walks from sidewalk to sidewalk.  
29  
30 KILLEN: So he went from the west side walked to the east  
31 side walkin' --  
32 P.O.GILMORE: Yes.

1

2 KILLEN: -- then he came back out in the street?

3 P.O.GILMORE: He went from the west sidewalk to the east  
4 sidewalk then to the street.

5

6 KILLEN: Okay and you're still in the street?

7 P.O.GILMORE: I'm in the street.

8

9 KILLEN: And your partner's still chasin' 'em?

10 P.O.GILMORE: Rich is still chasin' 'em.

11

12 KILLEN: Where's Officer Paruskiewicz do you know?

13 P.O.GILMORE: I don't know where Kevin showed up.

14

15 KILLEN: Okay.

16 P.O.GILMORE: All I know is I look and Kevin's on my side.

17

18 KILLEN: So what happens, so this guy comes back out in  
19 the street again and --20 P.O.GILMORE: He comes back out in the street and then uh  
21 he gets to the middle of the street almost to the  
22 middle of the block and uh he, with his right  
23 hand he turns left and I see the large uh gun  
24 with the extended magazine in his right hand.  
25 And he points it in the direction of me and my  
26 partners. And uh I yell out either gun, gun or  
27 he's got a gun, he's got a gun. And then I yell  
28 shoot, shoot. And then that's when I hear two  
29 rounds comin' from the left side of me. Uh I, I,  
30 I didn't know he got hit. Uh the gun drops to  
31 the ground. He stumbles and he goes down to the  
32 ground. I wasn't sure if he was hit or if he was

1           just scared. Um, (clears throat) so then we  
2           jumped on 'em and I went to handcuff 'em and  
3           that's when my hand went into all the blood up on  
4           the left side of his shoulder. And then we  
5           handcuffed 'em.

6

7   KILLEN: All right so prior, so throughout that whole time  
8           before he, he turns, you know he moves his right  
9           hand, he turns to the left, did you ever see 'em  
10          holdin' the pistol before that?

11   P.O.GILMORE: No.

12

13   KILLEN: That's the first time you see that?

14   P.O.GILMORE: That's the first time I saw that.

15

16   KILLEN: And you said it was a, an extended magazine on  
17          it?

18   P.O.GILMORE: Yeah.

19

20   KILLEN: I mean did you immediately recognize it to be a  
21          gun?

22   P.O.GILMORE: I did. I recovered uh couple days earlier  
23          the same a, a very similar gun. So I knew  
24          exactly what it was when he had it in his hand.

25

26   KILLEN: All right so when he pulls it up in his right  
27          hand, he twists to the left like you say, how far  
28          up is he from you at that point? If you had to  
29          guess?

30   P.O.GILMORE: If I had to guess it was maybe about 15 feet  
31          but we are closing cause we are still running



1                   towards 'em when he stopped and he turned towards  
2                   us.

3

4   KILLEN:        Okay.  And at that point uh you're still, you're,  
5                   you're in the street correct?

6   P.O.GILMORE:   Yes.

7

8   KILLEN:        And would you be facing north?

9   P.O.GILMORE:   I was facing north.

10

11   KILLEN:        Okay and he's still in the street?

12   P.O.GILMORE:   He's still in the street.

13

14   KILLEN:        And what, is there anything between you and him?

15   P.O.GILMORE:   No sir.  Just pavement.

16

17   KILLEN:        Okay.  And do at that point do you know where you  
18                   partner was at?

19   P.O.GILMORE:   No.  Uh it turns out he was back to my  
20                   right.  But I didn't, I didn't know where he was  
21                   at.

22

23   KILLEN:        Okay.  Did you know at that point where Officer  
24                   Paruskiewicz was?

25   P.O.GILMORE:   No like I said Kevin just appeared.  I don't  
26                   know where, how he got there.

27

28   KILLEN:        Okay.  All right.  And did, did the guy, Wesley  
29                   did he point the gun at you?

30   P.O.GILMORE:   He did.

31

1 KILLEN: Okay. And whaddid you do? Did you try to get  
2 outta the way or do you, whadda you do?

3 P.O.GILMORE: I pulled my gun and before I knew it Kevin  
4 was already takin' em out.  
5

6 KILLEN: Okay. And you said you, you're pretty clear on  
7 hearin' the two rounds?

8 P.O.GILMORE: I heard the two rounds.  
9

10 KILLEN: Okay.

11 P.O.GILMORE: They were real quick.  
12

13 KILLEN: Okay. And then you, you see this guy what he, he  
14 drops his gun?

15 P.O.GILMORE: I, I, I see the gun drop outta his hand. And  
16 then he runs a lil bit more and then he, he goes  
17 down.  
18

19 KILLEN: Where's he run to?

20 P.O.GILMORE: He runs to the sidewalk into the grass.  
21

22 KILLEN: East side, west side?

23 P.O.GILMORE: West side.  
24

25 KILLEN: All right where's the gun end up landing?

26 P.O.GILMORE: In the middle of the street.  
27

28 KILLEN: Okay. So and you guys, I know you said the words  
29 you used was jumped on 'em. Whadda you mean by  
30 that?

31 P.O.GILMORE: Uh we went down on him, went hands on and  
32 went to place handcuffs on 'em.

1

2 KILLEN: Did you, did you handcuff 'em?

3 P.O.GILMORE: Oh yeah.

4

5 KILLEN: Did you do it or one of the other guys?

6 P.O.GILMORE: I think somebody else did. They used my

7 handcuffs. I, I don't think I did it.

8

9 KILLEN: Okay.

10 P.O.GILMORE: I think Rich may have, I don't know who did

11 it.

12

13 KILLEN: Okay.

14 P.O.GILMORE: I was too busy, blood on my hands and I was

15 tellin' 'em to call an ambulance.

16

17 KILLEN: Okay. Do you know who called an ambulance?

18 P.O.GILMORE: I don't know.

19

20 KILLEN: Did you?

21 P.O.GILMORE: I don't think I did.

22

23 KILLEN: Okay. So then he gets handcuffed and, and what

24 happens from there?

25 P.O.GILMORE: Then the whole world comes and, and then uh

26 uh I think it was Sergeant Martin was the first

27 one, maybe Mike Decker was I don't know. But I

28 know I remember Dale bein' there cause I used to

29 work with him. And uh he starts handling the

30 scene. He's a sergeant.

31

32 KILLEN: Dale is Dale Martin?

1 P.O.GILMORE: Yeah.

2

3 KILLEN: Okay. Were you there, so Sergeant Martin shows  
4 up after he's handcuffed?

5 P.O.GILMORE: I think so. I think Dale was either  
6 arriving when it was happening or shortly  
7 thereafter.

8

9 KILLEN: All right. Were you present when they found the  
10 second pistol on 'em?

11 P.O.GILMORE: Yeah.

12

13 KILLEN: And wha, what did he have on 'em? What was the  
14 second gun? Do you know?

15 P.O.GILMORE: It was uh I don't even know what the color  
16 of the gun was. It was uh, it had a wooden  
17 handle and it was a sub-nosed.

18

19 KILLEN: Revolver?

20 P.O.GILMORE: Yes.

21

22 KILLEN: All right. And then going to the extended clip,  
23 do you um, that is still in the street correct?

24 P.O.GILMORE: That was in the street. Um, Rich went and

28 Wesley had, did you touch either of 'em?

29 P.O.GILMORE: No.

30

31 KILLEN: All right. Did any, did, do you know if anybody  
32 touched the semiautomatic with the extended clip?

1 P.O.GILMORE: I know for a fact, I don't know for a fact,  
2 but every time I saw it, it was being guarded  
3 either by Rich or uh by another officer that uh  
4 Sergeant Martin told 'em to watch. But nobody,  
5 everybody was standing up, nobody ever bent down.  
6

7 KILLEN: So as far as you know nobody picked it up and  
8 moved it or anything like that?

9 P.O.GILMORE: No, nobody ever picked it up or moved it  
10 from what I saw.  
11

12 KILLEN: All right. And then the gun that was found on,  
13 on, on uh Wesley do you know who actually found  
14 it?

A few seconds later the police car pulled up enough for the offender (Michael Westley) to be taken out of sight of the in-car camera, but still to be in sight of the gun in the street. At 10:53:47 P.M. officers ran towards Mr. Westley on the ground, including the officer that was standing next to the gun leaving it unoccupied. At 10:53:50 P.M. another officer who was running toward Mr. Westley stopped and stood next to the gun on the ground. At 11:01:43 P.M. an ambulance arrived on the scene. At 11:05:37 P.M. a stretcher was pulled out of the ambulance by the paramedics and brought to the area where Mr. Westley was lying. At 11:06:15 P.M. the video showed Mr. Westley being placed on the stretcher where only his feet were in view. The paramedics secured Mr. Westley onto the stretcher and took him to the ambulance, where he became out of sight. At 11:17:09 P.M. the ambulance pulled off.
