

At 10:53:47 P.M. officers ran towards Mr. Westley on the ground, including the officer that was standing next to the gun leaving it unoccupied. At 10:53:50 P.M. another officer who was running toward Mr. Westley stopped and stood next to the gun on the ground. At 11:01:43 P.M. an ambulance arrived on the scene. At 11:05:37 P.M. a stretcher was pulled out of the ambulance by the paramedics and brought to the area where Mr. Westley was lying. At 11:06:15 P.M. the video showed Mr. Westley being placed on the stretcher where only his feet were in view. A I directed -- I don't know who it was at the time nor do I know at this time -- I directed an officer to sit on a, uh, the offender's pistol, which was laying in the middle of the street, at, uh, at the -- approximately 6610 Sangamon. It was in the middle of the street. I don't know the exact address.
