SUBJECT: Response to Medical Examiner's Office

On 17 June 2013, at approximately 0820 hours, the R/I and IPRA Intern Aleksandra Bielawiec went to the Cook County Medical Examiner's office in order to observe the postmortem examination of Michael Westley (ME # 274JUN13). Dr. Stephen Cina performed the examination.

The R/I observed the subject's unclothed remains and saw that he had been intubated and that he had what appeared to be surgical stitches on the left side of his chest. Dr. Cina identified a chest tube insertion incision on the right side of Westley's chest.


The R/I observed Westley's clothing which consisted of one pair of khaki-colored cargo shorts, one pair of multi-colored print shorts, one pair of white ankle length socks, one pair of gray Nike brand basketball shoes, and one black short sleeved t-shirt. Dr. Cina identified an apparent bullet hole in the left sleeve of the black t-shirt. Evidence Technician Dawson inventoried the clothing.

Dr. Cina showed the R/I postmortem x-rays of Westley's body. Dr. Cina noted that there was a spent round lodged in the right side of Westley's chest.


Dr. Cina identified a gunshot entry wound to Westley's left upper arm. The round then exited Westley's left upper arm and entered the left side of his chest. The round traveled through Westley's chest from left to right. Dr. Cina stated that the bullet went through Westley's left lung, through his pulmonary artery and right ventricle and into Westley's right lung. Dr. Cina stated that he did not observe any powder or tattooing around the entrance wound. Dr. Cina stated that the lack of powder or tattooing indicates that Westley was not shot at close range.

Dr. Cina used two testing strips to test for evidence of ingestion of cocaine and morphine in Westley's urine. Dr. Cina indicated that the tests were both negative but that blood toxicology testing was still required.

Dr. Cina stated that the cause of death was a gunshot wound to the arm and the manner was homicide.

4 were fired at?
5 P.O.SCHMIDT: Yes it was in the vicinity of 6-6 and
6 Sangamon on Morgan area.
7
8 MORLEY: And who uh who called out the shots fired? Was
9 that the dispatcher or do you recall?
10 P.O.SCHMIDT: Uh I believe it was an officer who heard the
11 shots.
12
13 MORLEY: Okay. And uh what happened after you --
14 P.O.SCHMIDT: (clears throat)
15
16 MORLEY: -- you all heard the call come out?
17 P.O.SCHMIDT: We approached uh 6-6 and Sangamon. As we
18 were approaching I observed um, a male black
19 wearing white shorts and a black t-shirt running
20 eastbound towards our vehicle, but we were still
21 like a half a block away on 66th.
22
23 MORLEY: Okay and just to back up a lil bit. Um, what
24 type of vehicle were you in?
25 P.O.SCHMIDT: Unmarked Tahoe.
26
27 MORLEY: An unmarked Tahoe. Uh does that Tahoe have a in-
28 car camera --
29 P.O.SCHMIDT: No.
30
31 MORLEY: -- setup with an in-car camera?
32 P.O.SCHMIDT: No ma'am it doesn't.

1

2 MORLEY: Do you know the uh (someone clears throat) the
3 vehicle number on that Tahoe?

4 P.O.SCHMIDT: 2-6-3-4 I believe.

5

6 MORLEY: Okay.

7 P.O.SCHMIDT: Almost positive.

8

9 MORLEY: And are you the passenger or the driver?

10 P.O.SCHMIDT: I'm the passenger.

11

12 MORLEY: You're the passenger. Okay so you, you hear the,
13 the call come out. Can you explain what route
14 you took from where you --

15 P.O.SCHMIDT: Straight down 66th heading west.

16

17 MORLEY: Okay. So you head down 66th, 66th heading west.

18 P.O.SCHMIDT: Correct.

19

20 MORLEY: And you observe this male black.

21 P.O.SCHMIDT: Yes ma'am.

22

23 MORLEY: Where do you observe him exactly?

24 P.O.SCHMIDT: Um, he's on the north side, there's a corner
25 there of the store on the northwest cor,
26 northwest corner of 6-6 and Sangamon.

28 MORLEY: Okay and what is he doin' when you observe him?

11 shots fired or if he's involved in them. He then
12 proceeds to run eastbound across the street so
13 now he's on the east side of the middle block of
14 Sangamon. He then runs northbound down Sangamon.

17 running southbound on Sangamon correct?

31 Paruskiewicz, then I hear two gunshots ring out.

2 he's running you know crossing the streets, do
3 you see this gun at any point?

4 P.O.SCHMIDT: No ma'am.

6 MORLEY: Is the first time you see this gun, what is he
7 doing with the gun when you see --

8 P.O.SCHMIDT: It's directed to, towards Officer
9 Paruskiewicz.

10

11 MORLEY: Okay. And again when you saw the gun did you
12 identify it right away as a gun or --

13 P.O.SCHMIDT: Yes.

14

15 MORLEY: Okay and how did you know that it was, it was a
16 gun?

17 P.O.SCHMIDT: Through my previous experience as a police

20 MORLEY: Okay. And uh again can you describe the gun for

7 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: Uh back in January. I don't remember
8 the exact date, but I, I know it was in January.
9

10 MORLEY: January of this year, 2013?

11 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: Yes.
12

13 MORLEY: Okay. Do you have that gun registered to the
14 City of uh Chicago?

15 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: Yes.
16

17 MORLEY: Okay. And it was registered on that date?

18 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: Yes.
19

20 MORLEY: Do you have a current uh Illinois Firearm Owner
21 Identification Card?

22 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: Yes.
23

24 MORLEY: Do you have any other fire, did you have any
25 other firearms on your person on the date of the
26 incident?

27 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: No.
28

29 MORLEY: Okay. Were you carrying a um less than lethal
30 weapon on that date um to include baton, pepper
31 spray or a taser?

32 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: I had pepper spray.

1

2 MORLEY: Okay. During your tour of duty on that date,
3 were you involved in an incident that um
4 involved, an incident that resulted in a shoot,
5 in a shooting?

6 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: Yes.

7

8 MORLEY: In a shooting of a male identified as uh Wesley?
9 (recorder is being moved)

10 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: Yes.

11

12 MORLEY: (pause) Can you explain to me from the beginning
13 (recorder being moved) of the incident um where
14 (moving recorder) you were in and how the call
15 came out?

16 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: Okay at the beginning my partner and I
17 were sitting at a gas station parking lot at 67th
18 and Halsted. Uh where we go regularly cause
19 there's a lot of trouble at that gas station so
20 we usually go there to try to get some of the
21 people away from there and we regularly talk to
22 the uh gas station attendant there. While we
23 were, there was a call of multiple shots fired in
24 the area of 65th and Sangamon, Green and Peoria.
25 And so we were right down the street so we
26 responded to the call. Uh so then I proceeded to
27 go northbound on Halsted, then I went left on, or
28 went westbound on 66th Street as we were traveling
29 west, as I was driving westbound I see a male
30 black with a black t-shirt, white shorts running
31 by himself and he was running from the direction
32 of Morgan which is west of Sangamon. Uh toward

1 an alley in the, the west alley of the 6600 block
2 of Sangamon and he was running southbound. So I
3 follow 'em in the car and as we get down the
4 alley about half way through the alley he starts,
5 he stops and starts to walk. So then I put the
6 car in park.

7

8 MORLEY: I'm gonna stop you right there. When the call
9 came out, what exac, how, how exactly did the
10 call come out?

11 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: It was a call of shots fired. Multiple
12 and it's uh that it sounded like an automatic
13 weapon.

14

15 MORLEY: Okay.

16 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: Cause it was multiple shots.

17

18 MORLEY: And who put the call out? Was that a, another
19 officer or was that the um dispatcher? Do you
20 recall?

21 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: Well it was, the call was given out by
22 dispatcher, but I don't know who you know who
23 called it in. I don't know if it was a citizen
24 or if it was another officer.

25

26 MORLEY: When you heard the call, did they give a
27 description of who was shooting or was it just
28 shots fired?

29 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: It was just shots fired.

30

31 MORLEY: Okay. So go ahead. You put your partner, your
32 car in park.

1 P.O. PARUSKIEWICZ: And I, I proceed to get out so I can
2 detain the subject and question him. And as soon
3 as I get outta the car, he starts running back
4 northbound down the alley. So now I'm on foot
5 chasing after him down, back down to 66th Street.
6 Then he cuts east now I'm still foo, running
7 after 'em on foot. Then he goes, then he
8 proceeds to go southbound on Sangamon and I'm
9 still following 'em. The whole time I have my
10 radio in my hand. I'm giving a description of
11 this guy and I'm giving the location of where I'm
12 running. And then uh get about half way down
13 Sangamon and then he starts to go diagonally, cut
14 across toward Peoria. And now at the time I see
15 another unmarked Tahoe pull up. I don't know
16 which officers were in the car at the time. Um,
17 he goes around the car and then he starts to cut
18 back northwest across the street again. Now this
19 time the other two officers that got outta the
20 car are running behind me. And the whole time
21 I'm trying to tell this guy to, I'm shouting
22 stop, police. And then I could hear the other
23 two officers behind me shouting stop. And by
24 hearing them shout stop I can, I recognized who
25 they were.

26

27 MORLEY: Okay I'm gonna stop you again one more time. So
28 when you, when you put your car in park and, and
29 you start running after him, are you sayin'
30 anything to him? Is he sayin' anything? Is
31 there any, any verbal contact between the two of
32 you?

1 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: The only thing I'm doin' is tellin' 'em
2 to, tryin' to tell 'em to stop. He's not sayin'
3 anything to me.

4
5 MORLEY: Did you identify yourself as a, a Chicago Police
6 officer, as an officer or anything?

7 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: As I, I just kept shouting stop police.

8
9 MORLEY: Okay. And what, what was this individual um,
10 can you describe him, can you describe what he
11 was wearin'?

12 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: He was a male black with short hair,
13 wearing a black t-shirt and white shorts.

14
15 MORLEY: Okay. So you're, you're running after him and
16 that's when he turns northbound down the alley
17 then eastbound on 66th and then southbound again
18 on Sangamon?

19 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: Correct.

20
21 MORLEY: And as you're running are you running, are you
22 guys running on the street, on the sidewalk? And
23 what side of the, what side of --

24 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: Initially we're on the sidewalk on the
25 west side of Sangamon.

26
27 MORLEY: Okay.

28 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: And then he, he cuts across the street
29 going eastbound toward Peoria.

30
31 MORLEY: Okay.

1 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: So the other side of the street which
2 woulda been toward Peoria.

3

4 MORLEY: Okay. Which is a block east --

5 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: Peoria is a block east of Sangamon.

6

7 MORLEY: East of Sangamon, okay.

8 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: However he never, he never made it to
9 Peoria. Once he got across the other side of the
10 street, he turned around because the other
11 officers got outta the car and started chasing
12 'em. But I got in front and I started you know
13 I, I turned around and I started followin' 'em
14 again, started chasin' after 'em. Now when we
15 got back, we got back into the middle of the
16 street as I'm telling him to stop he turns around
17 and he points a weapon at me. Like directly at
18 me.

19

20 MORLEY: Okay.

21 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: And I see the weapon, I, I don't know,
22 I, I couldn't recall what hand he had it in. Or
23 which way he turned, all I remember is him doing
24 is turning around pointin' the gun directly at
25 me.

26

27 MORLEY: Prior to when you guys are running, when you're
28 running after him, do you see a weapon um, in his
29 hands or on him at any point?

30 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: No.

31

1 MORLEY: You don't. And you said he's, he's pretty much
2 zigzagging between, on Sangamon between the east
3 and west side of the sidewalk correct?

4 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: Yes.
5

6 MORLEY: Um and that's when you see the officers in the
7 Tahoe. When they get out do you hear them say
8 anything to him as well or?

9 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: I hear them telling him to stop.
10

11 MORLEY: And who are these officers?

12 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: Uh Officer --

13 DAHMS: (whispers to client)

14 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: I, I knew them by the recognition of
15 their voice.
16

17 MORLEY: You know the officers by the recognition --

18 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: Officers by the recognition.
19

20 MORLEY: Okay and who did you recognize them to be?

21 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: Uh recognized them to be Officer Pat
22 Gilmore and Officer Richard Schmidt.
23

24 MORLEY: Okay. And again do, you said you did hear them
25 sayin' it?

26 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: Yes.
27

28 MORLEY: And what were they saying?

29 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: They were, they were telling him to
30 stop.
31

1 MORLEY: Stop. Did they identify themselves? Did you
2 hear them identifying themselves as at any point?

3 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: I didn't hear that, all I heard 'em say
4 was stop.
5

6 MORLEY: At what point um, did, do you draw your weapon?

7 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: When we were, right at, when we were in
8 the middle of the street, when he turned around
9 and I saw the gun, then all of a sudden I hear
10 behind me I hear, I hear gun, gun, shoot, shoot.
11 And then it was one quick motion I, I, I just I
12 drew my weapon and I was still running at 'em. I
13 pointed with just one hand and I shot, I fired
14 two quick shots and then um right after that I
15 saw, I saw him drop the weapon in the middle of
16 the street. Then he stumbled into the grass and
17 fell.
18

19 MORLEY: Okay. Did you see the weapon be heard, before
20 you heard gun, gun or did you, did it happen at
21 the same time?

22 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: Right af, it was, he pointed it at me
23 and then right after he pointed it at me that's
24 when I heard gun, gun.
25

26 MORLEY: And you recognized it to be a gun?

27 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: Yes.
28

29 MORLEY: And how did you recognize it to be a gun?

30 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: Cause it was, I could see the, the blue
31 steel barrel pointed right at me.
32

1 MORLEY: Okay. What um, what hand was he holding it in?
2 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: That I don't recall.
3
4 MORLEY: Do you know where he took it out from?
5 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: No I don't.
6
7 MORLEY: You don't, you just saw him --
8 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: I just saw him --
9
10 MORLEY: -- pointing it at you.
11 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: -- pull it out and point it.
12
13 MORLEY: Okay. And where are um, the officers uh Officer
14 Gilmore and Schmidt, where, where are they in
15 relation to you?
16 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: They were behind me.
17
18 MORLEY: They were behind you. You don't know how far
19 they are?
20 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: No I, I --
21
22 MORLEY: At this point.
23 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: -- I don't know how far they were.
24
25 MORLEY: And how far is, is um, uh Wesley?
26 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: Um, from what I, when I shot him we
27 were, I was approximately ten feet away from him.
28
29 MORLEY: Okay. (recorder being moved) And when you drew
30 your weapon, what, what hand um did you use?
31 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: My left hand.
32

1 MORLEY: And is that your, did you say that's your primary
2 shooting hand?

3 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: Yes.
4

5 MORLEY: Okay. Did any of the other officers draw their
6 weapon that, that you know of?

7 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: I don't recall because they were both
8 behind me.
9

10 MORLEY: Okay so after you hear the gun, gun shoot, you
11 shoot your weapon?

12 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: Yes.
13

14 MORLEY: Okay. And what happens after that?

15 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: Right after that, after I fire my
16 weapon then I see, I see him drop his weapon in
17 the street, right in the middle of the street.
18 And then he stumbles over to the grass and falls.
19

20 MORLEY: Did he fire his weapon at, at you at all, Mr. --

21 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: No.
22

23 MORLEY: -- uh Wesley?

24 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: No.
25

26 MORLEY: And how many times did you um did you fire?

27 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: Twice.
28

29 MORLEY: Did you observe where uh Wesley was hit?

30 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: It wasn't until after he fell to the
31 ground.
32

1 MORLEY: Okay. And what was the reason you stopped
2 firing?

3 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: Uh the threat was gone. Threat of,
4 threat of bodily harm was gone. So I reholstered
5 my weapon.
6

7 MORLEY: What was, what was the lighting condition in the
8 area?

9 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: There was good artificial lighting from
10 the street lights.
11

12 MORLEY: From, from where the, from the stop where you
13 stop him in the alley all the way to um, where
14 the incident ended where you fired your weapon,
15 would you say it was the same amount of lighting
16 or did the lighting change at any point?

17 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: It, well there was, in the alley there
18 was a little bit more lighting than when I got to
19 66th Street. But then when I got back on Sangamon
20 there was a little bit better lighting.
21

22 MORLEY: Okay and just to clarify, did Wesley ever say
23 anything to you?

24 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: Never said anything to me.
25

26 MORLEY: And other than you announcing police, you know
27 stop did you say anything else?

28 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: No.
29

30 MORLEY: Okay. During the, um, during this incident did
31 you experience tunnel vision?

32 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: No.

1

2 MORLEY: What about auditory exclusion?

3 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: Uh no.

4

5 MORLEY: Okay. And again just I, I wanna make sure I
6 cover everything. When your, when you're running
7 after him and you guys are in the middle of the
8 street and you see him zigzagging, um, can you
9 explain to me again when you guys stop and he
10 turns around and points the weapon. How exactly
11 did he turn? Is he running southbound and then -

12

13 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: No at the time uh at the time when he
14 turned he was running northwest.

15

16 MORLEY: He was running northwest, okay. And that was
17 when he initially he was, he (inaudible) side of
18 the street then --

19 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: He was --

20

21 MORLEY: -- running towards Peoria.

22 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: Correct.

23

24 MORLEY: And then double backed. Were there any vehicles
25 um, separating you guys at that point? Or --

26 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: Uh no.

27

28 MORLEY: Okay. At the time that you discharged your
29 weapon, did you have any other option when it
30 came to stopping the threat to you or other
31 individuals in the area?

1 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: I uh I uh was in fear for my life and I
2 felt that there was no other option than use
3 deadly force.
4

5 MORLEY: Okay. So after Wesley went down, um can you
6 explain again what, what happened after that?

7 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: Uh after he went down then I, I
8 reholstered my weapon, walked over to him and
9 then uh the other two officers Gilmore and
10 Schmidt went over there and um, that's uh one of
11 those two officers cuffed 'em. I don't recall
12 which one did. Um, but that's when we observed
13 that he was shot. So then right after we found
14 out, we observed that he was shot, I called for
15 an ambulance.
16

17 MORLEY: Okay. And what happened after that?

18 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: And then after, after I called for an
19 ambulance, I, I just stood to the side waited and
20 then uh bunch of other officers responded to the
21 scene. And I uh went and sat in a squad car and
22 waited for um, the investigators to come by and -
23 -

24

25 MORLEY: Were you there when uh Sergeant Martin arrived?

26 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: I was still there, yes.
27

28 MORLEY: You were still there.

29 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: But I was sitting in a car.
30

31 MORLEY: Okay. Were you present when uh second gun was
32 recovered?

1 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: Uh I was still, I was sitting in a car
2 so I wasn't aware at the time that a second gun
3 was recovered. I was, I was informed about it.

4

5 MORLEY: Okay what were you informed about the second gun
6 uh recovered?

7 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: I was informed that a 38 uh revolver
8 was recovered from one of his pockets. But I
9 don't know which one.

10

11 MORLEY: And did you know Wesley from any other um
12 encounters or was this the first time you had,
13 you encountered him or did you know him before
14 this?

15 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: Uh no this was my first encounter with
16 him.

17

18 MORLEY: Okay. And Officer Gilmore and Officer Schmidt
19 had you worked with them prior to?

20 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: Yes.

21

22 MORLEY: Okay. And that's how you recognized 'em by
23 voice?

24 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: Yes.

25

26 MORLEY: Okay. Are you aware of the type of uh weapon
27 that was recovered um the second weapon that was
28 recovered from him, from Wesley?

29 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: The second weapon or --

30

31 MORLEY: Yes. The second.

32 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: -- the revolver.

1

2 MORLEY: The revo, okay, the revolver, okay.

3 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: Um, the second or do you want the first
4 one?

5

6 MORLEY: The, can you tell me about the first one.

7 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: Uh after he dropped it to the ground,
8 then I observed that there was an extended
9 magazine on it.

10

11 MORLEY: Do you know what type of gun that fell on the
12 ground, what type of gun it was?

13 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: I don't know exactly sure, some, I was
14 told that it could be, could possibly be a 40
15 caliber Glock. But I wasn't, we weren't told for
16 sure. All I, and now I know is there was, had an
17 extended magazine on it.

18

19 MORLEY: Okay. And then the second gun I know you said
20 you weren't there when it was recovered. Um, --

21 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: Correct.

22

23 MORLEY: -- do you know what type of gun that, that was,
24 that was recovered?

25 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: I just, I was told, I was informed that
26 it was a 38 revolver.

27

28 MORLEY: Okay, perfect. And when he, before you shoot
29 your, your weapon, before you shoot uh Wesley,
30 when he pointed, pointed the weapon at you,
31 whaddid you think he was going to do?

1 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: I felt that he was going to shoot and

4 MORLEY: Okay. Okay. And as far as the, the, the two
5 guns that were recovered, um, prior to you going
6 to sit in the car, did you touch either of the
7 weapons?

8 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: No I did not.

9

10 MORLEY: Okay. Do you know if anybody else touched them?

11 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: I'm not aware of that.

12

13 MORLEY: Okay.

14 KILLEN: Yeah you may have said it before, um, you, you
15 were at 67th and Halsted at the gas station right?
16 You hear a call shots fired.

17 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: Yeah.

18

19 KILLEN: Did you actually hear shots?

20 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: No we didn't hear shots.

21

22 KILLEN: Okay. And then cause you said that you said, you
23 said it sounded like it came from a
24 semiautomatic? I don't --

25 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: But no it sounded uh the call came it
26 sounded, that it came from an automatic weapon.

27

28 KILLEN: An automatic.

29 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: Yeah.

31 KILLEN: Well that was said over the radio. Oh I'm sorry
32 I thought, I thought you heard shots.

1 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: No, no, no. No that was, it was a call
2 that came on the radio.

3

4 KILLEN: Okay. And then so you follow, you see Wesley and
5 you go in the alley behind 'em right? You're in
6 your car still?

7 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: Yes.

8

9 KILLEN: And then he stops runnin', he starts walkin'.

10 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: Yeah we pulled up next to 'em in the
11 alley.

12

13 KILLEN: Do have like sirens goin' at this point? Or just

14 --

15 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: On, on the way there we did.

16

17 KILLEN: You did.

18 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: Yeah.

19

20 KILLEN: So when you're in the alley do you?

21 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: No not, not in the alley.

22

23 KILLEN: Does he ever turn to look atcha? Like even
24 before --

25 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: When, when we pulled up in the car in
26 the alley or pulled up next to 'em in the alley,
27 he looked, he looked at us. He was, he was on
28 the passenger side of the car.

29

30 KILLEN: Would he have been still in front of you though?

31 Or is he directly out like --

1 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: No he's, he was directly on the
2 passenger side of the car. Cause I pulled --
3
4 KILLEN: Is that when he took off runnin'?
5 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: Yeah.
6
7 KILLEN: Okay so that's how he got passed you guys he's on
8 the side of you.
9 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: Yeah.
10
11 KILLEN: Okay. That's all I had.
12 MORLEY: Is uh, is there anything else that you wish to
13 add to this statement?
14 DAHMS: (whispers to client)
15 KILLEN: I got one more real quick, you said before you,
16 you answered you only fired twice because the
17 threat was no longer there. Right? Whaddayou
18 mean by the threat's no longer there?
19 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: Um, he, he dropped the weapon. So I, I
20 was you know that was the only weapon I was, I
21 was aware of him having. So once he dropped the
22 weapon I wasn't at that time I wasn't in fear for
23 my life anymore.
24
25 KILLEN: Okay. So (inaudible)
26 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: Yeah.
27
28 KILLEN: Okay.
29 MORLEY: And when you're running after him about
30 approximately how far are you from him um, --
31 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: When I'm, when I'm running after him
32 I'm 'bout 15,20 feet from him.

1

2 MORLEY: And again during this whole um, incident,
3 starting from the vehicle to um, Sangamon in the
4 middle of the street, once you guys, once you
5 arrived there um, and he points the weapon at
6 you, you didn't, there was no other option when
7 it came to you stopping the threat?

8 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: Right I was, I was in fear for my life.
9 I thought that he was, I felt that he was gonna
10 kill me or my partners. So I just felt that
11 there was no other option than to use deadly
12 force.

13

14 MORLEY: Okay.

15 KILLEN: If he had shot at you would you have been able to
16 gain cover?

17 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: Uh no.

18 DAHMS: You were in the middle --

19 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: We were in the middle of the street.

20

21 KILLEN: Okay.

22 MORLEY: Is there anything else that you wish to add?

23 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: No.

24

25 MORLEY: Okay. Is this the uh true and accurate account
26 of what occurred on that, on the night of uh 16
27 of June 2013 uh to the best of your knowledge?

28 P.O.PARUSKIEWICZ: Yes.




The law provides that you are to be advised of the following:
